## AMERICAN WHITE WINES

### SAUVIGNON (FUMÉ) BLANC

Another versatile variety, the Sauvignon Blanc grape is used to produce both "Fumé" and Sauvignon Blanc wines. In France this varietal is used widely in the Bordeaux and Upper Loire Regions, where it is responsible for producing the famous "Pouilly Fumé," "Graves" and "Sancerre" wines. In California its success is second only to Chardonnay for yielding high quality, dry white wines.

The best of these wines from California are made in a dry style with ample fruit creating a supple, interesting, grassy-herbaceous flavor.

## AMERICAN WHITE WINES

### JOHANNISBERG RIESLING

The true German Riesling is known in America as Johannisberg Riesling or White Riesling, and only those wines made from the true Riesling may carry either one of these designations.

## AMERICAN BLUSH WINES

An interesting newcomer to California's offerings of white wines is the Blush wine category. In France, blush wines are known as "Blanc de Noir" which translates, "white from black," referring to the process of making a white wine from a dark-skinned grape. In California the names most often given to these wines are "White Zinfandel," "Pinot Noir Blanc" or "White Cabernet (Blanc)" referring to the specific dark-skinned grape variety from which the wine has been vinified. Blush wines may be enjoyed as a cocktail wine, but also complement a wide variety of foods. These wines are typically light and refreshing, a delicate pink blush color with a touch of sweetness in the finish.

## MERITAGE

*The Meritage designation is for wines that are blended entirely (100%) from the eight traditional Bordeaux grape varieties. The Wineries may use as few as two varieties or as many as all eight varieties in the blends. Most wineries have elected to use only three or four varieties, usually preferring Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. These wines tend to be very complex, showing great balance and elegance.*
