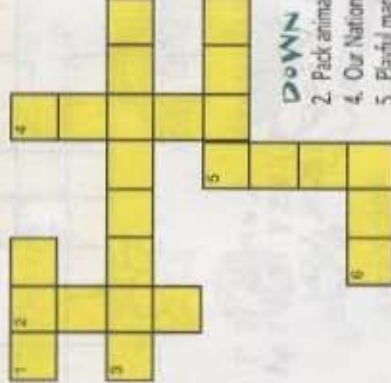
The number of Rhesus Monkeys has dropped dramatically resulting from their use as research animals.

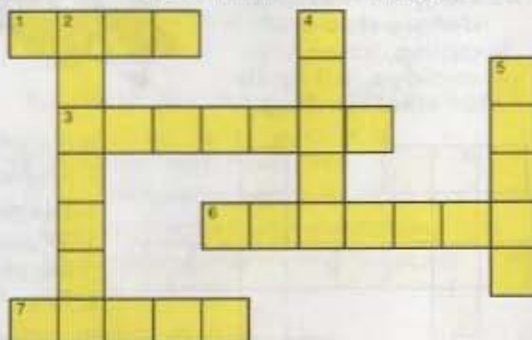
