Lychee

(Litchi Chinensis)

The Lychee is an attractive, slow growing evergreen tree which grows to 10-12 metres (35-40ft).

Lychee trees originated from China where they have been cultivated since ancient times and were introduced to Australia by the Chinese gold seekers during the early 1870's gold rush. Lychees have adapted well to Australian conditions and very sweet fruit is produced with only the faintest taste of acidity. The white translucent flesh is best eaten raw and can benefit from refrigeration to enhance the fine flavour and texture. Lychees can be also eaten in fruit salads and are tasty in dishes with pork or chicken.


