### GEORGE SHINN

George Shinn is a successful educator, business executive, author and lecturer.

Mr. Shinn's formal education was received at a small business school in his home state of North Carolina; he has also received five honorary doctorate degrees. He was the youngest person ever to win the prestigious Horatio Alger Award and the second North Carolinian to win this honor.

Mr. Shinn owns the Rutledge College chain of proprietary schools and other corporations in such diverse areas as automobile dealerships, real estate, construction, printing, publishing and leadership seminars. He is widely known for his efforts to bring professional sports to the Carolinas.

### MICHAEL R. DANIEL

Michael R. Daniel, Lieutenant Governor of South Carolina, was elected to the House of Representatives in 1972 and served for ten years. In 1982 he was elected South Carolina's 81st Lieutenant Governor.

Lieutenant Governor Daniel has focused much of his time promoting the State's economic development and improving its educational system. Under his leadership, private enterprise and government have joined hands to develop small business and technology centers across the state of South Carolina.



### MICHAEL J. GRISANTI

Michael J. Grisanti, President of Grisanti, Inc., recently merged with Imasco USA, Inc., based in Rocky Mount, North Carolina.

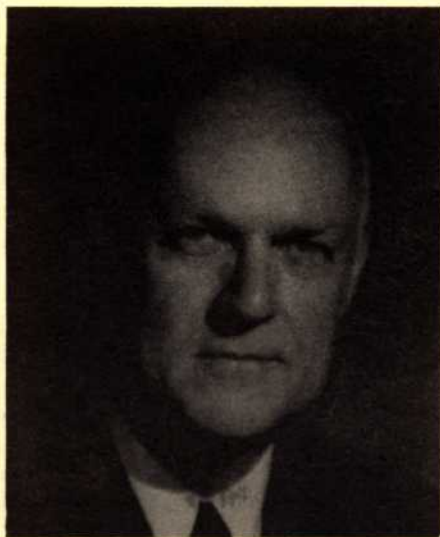


### CHARLES E. PALMER
