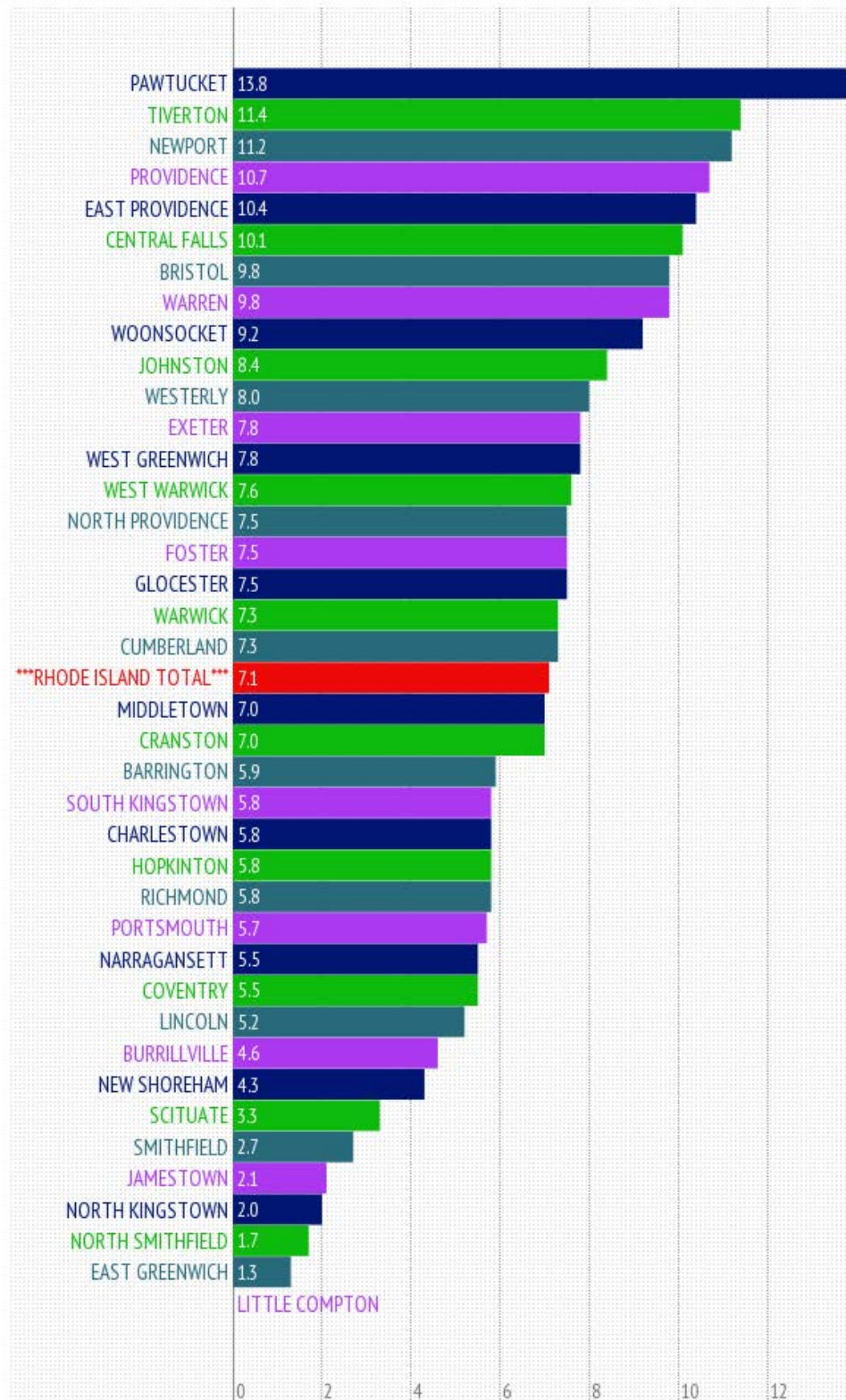

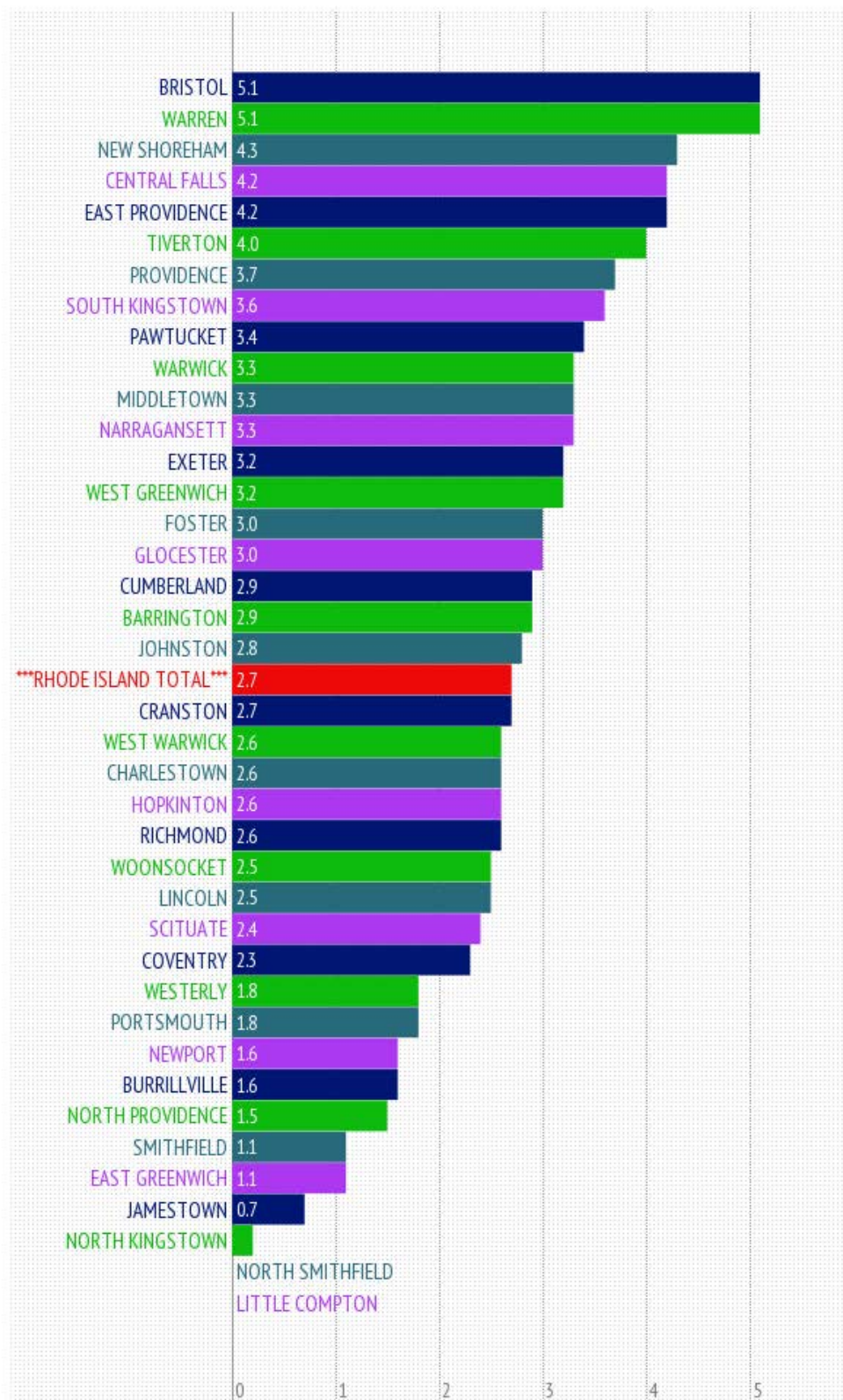

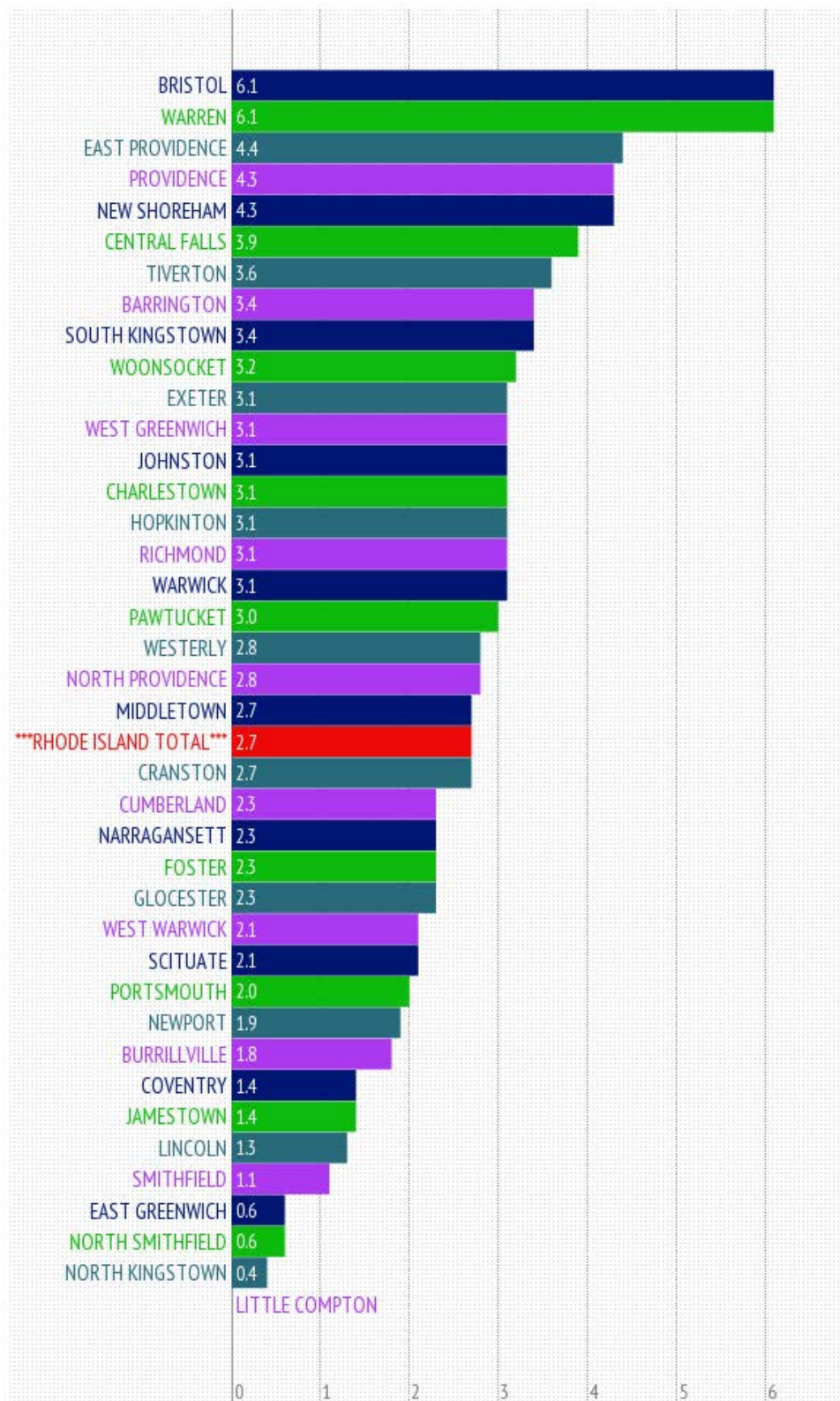


## Middle School Inhalant Use 2012-2013



The percent of middle school students in the 2012-2013 school year that responded "yes" to the question, "Have you tried inhalants (huffing)?"

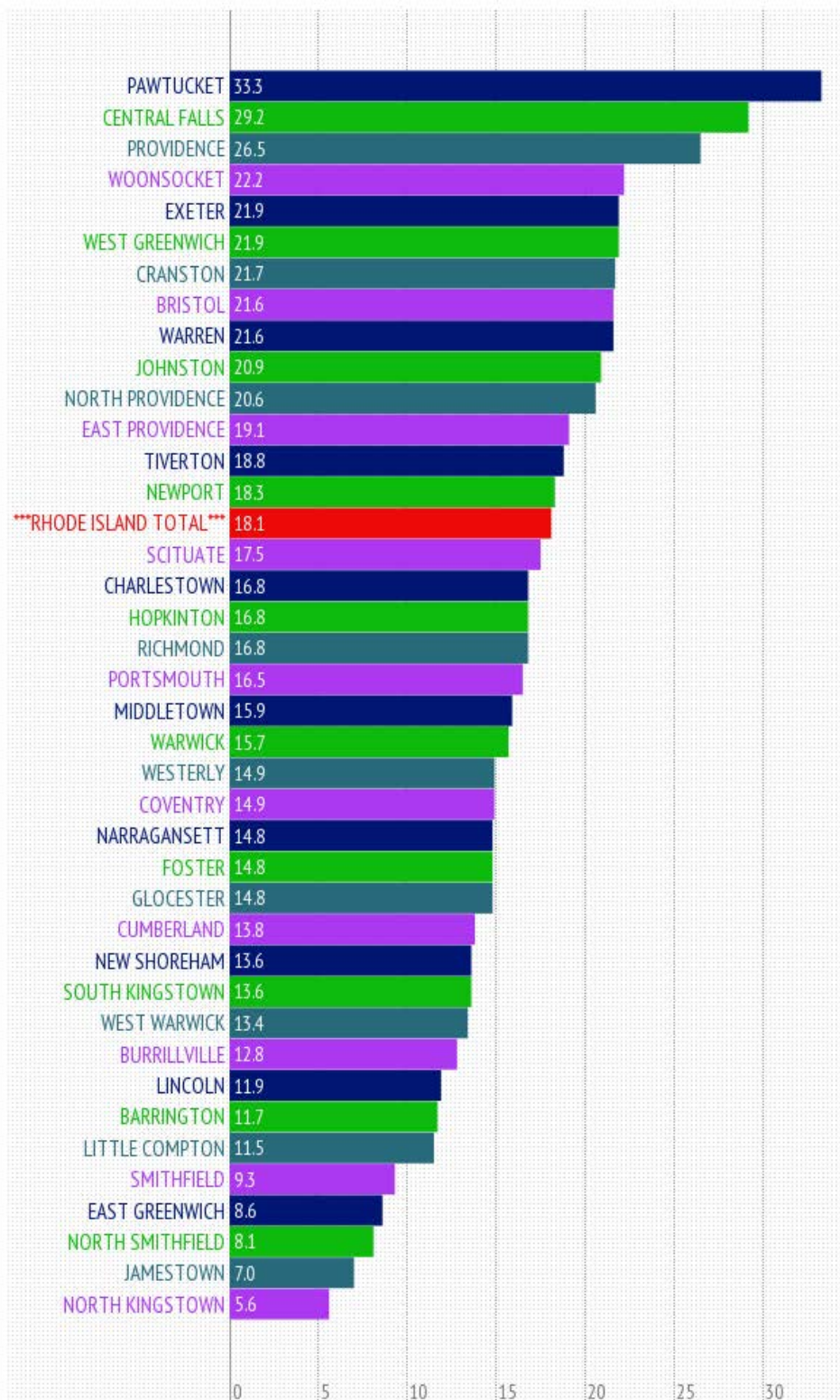
## Middle School Other Illegal Drug Use 2012-2013

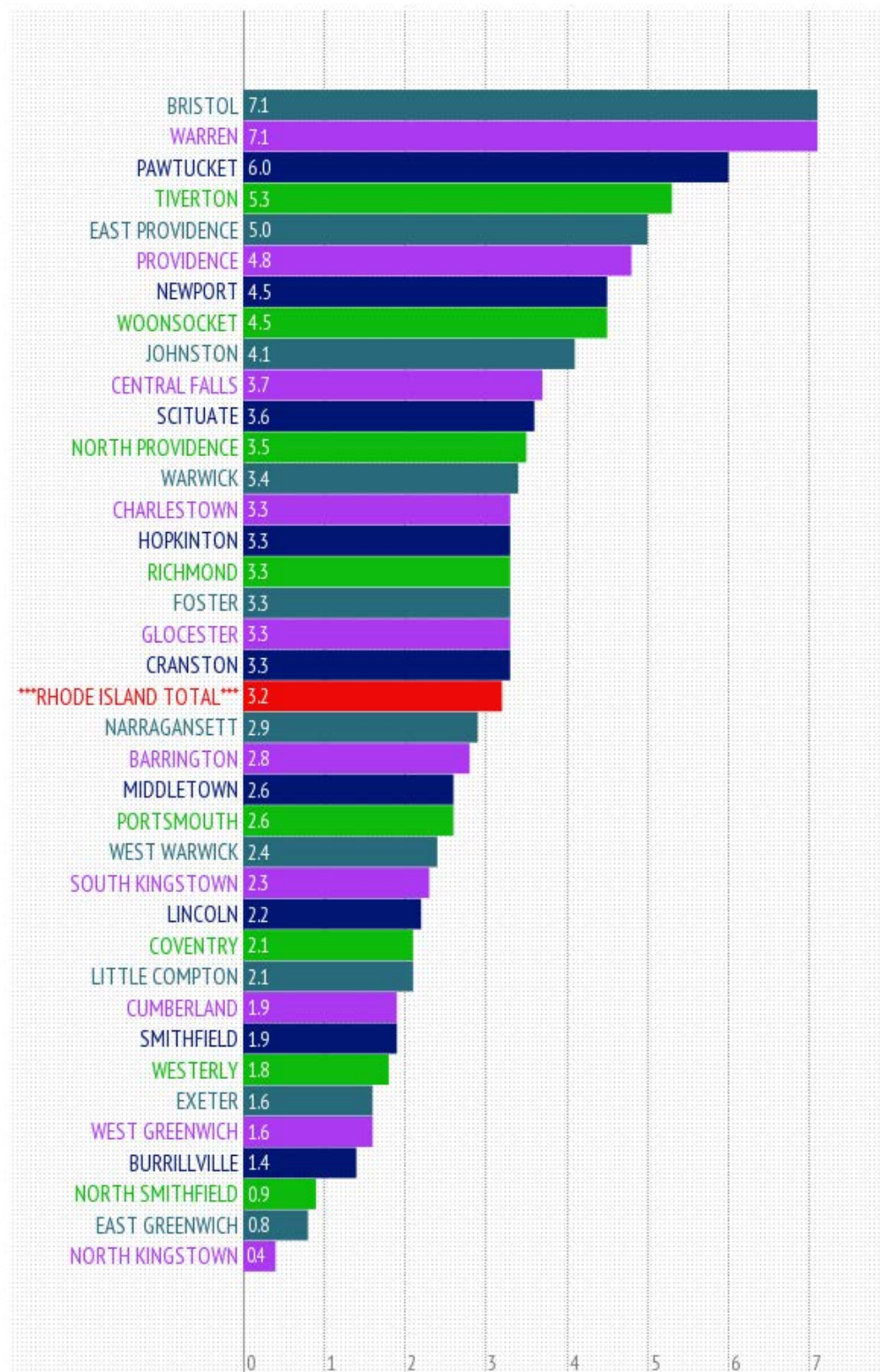

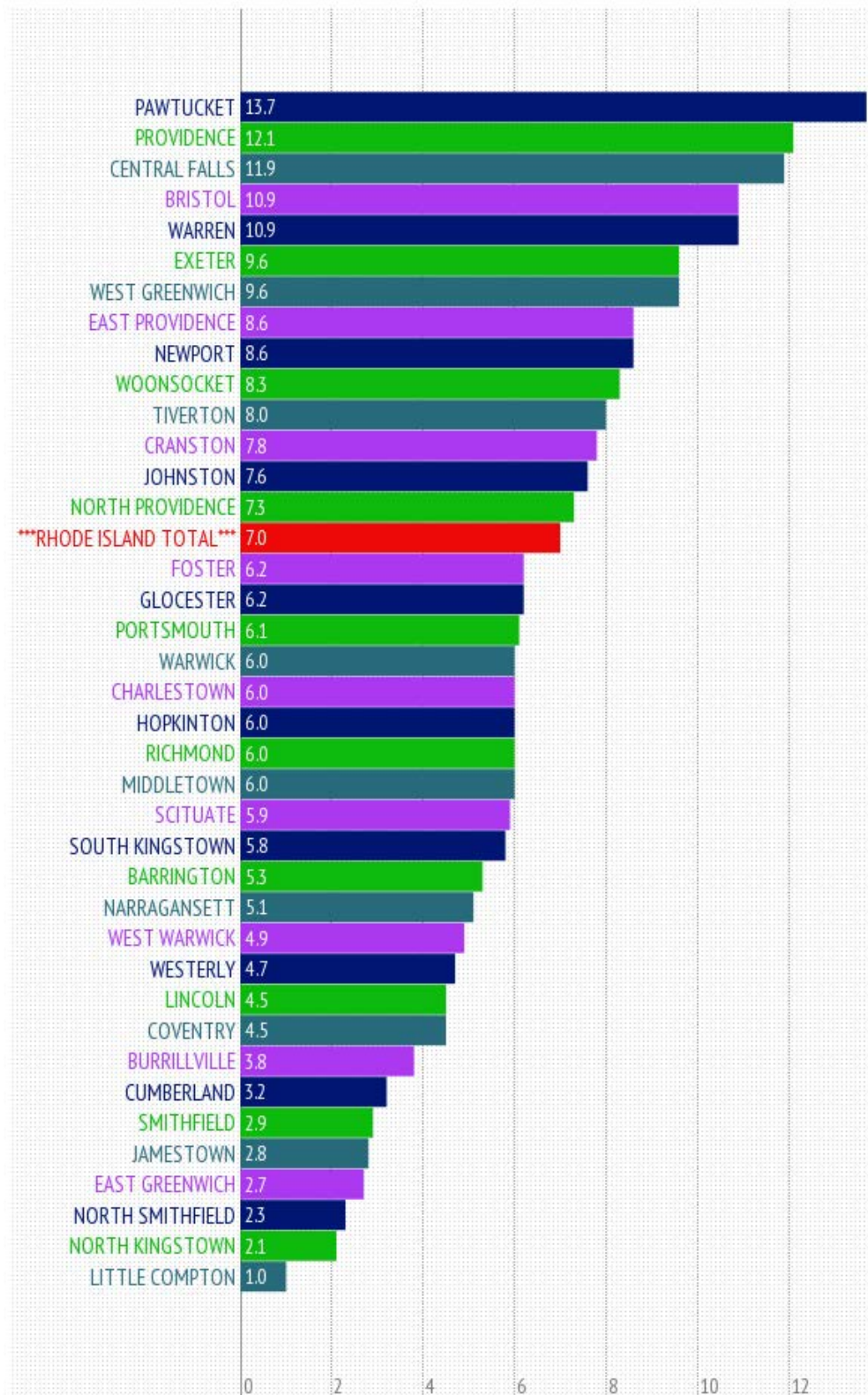

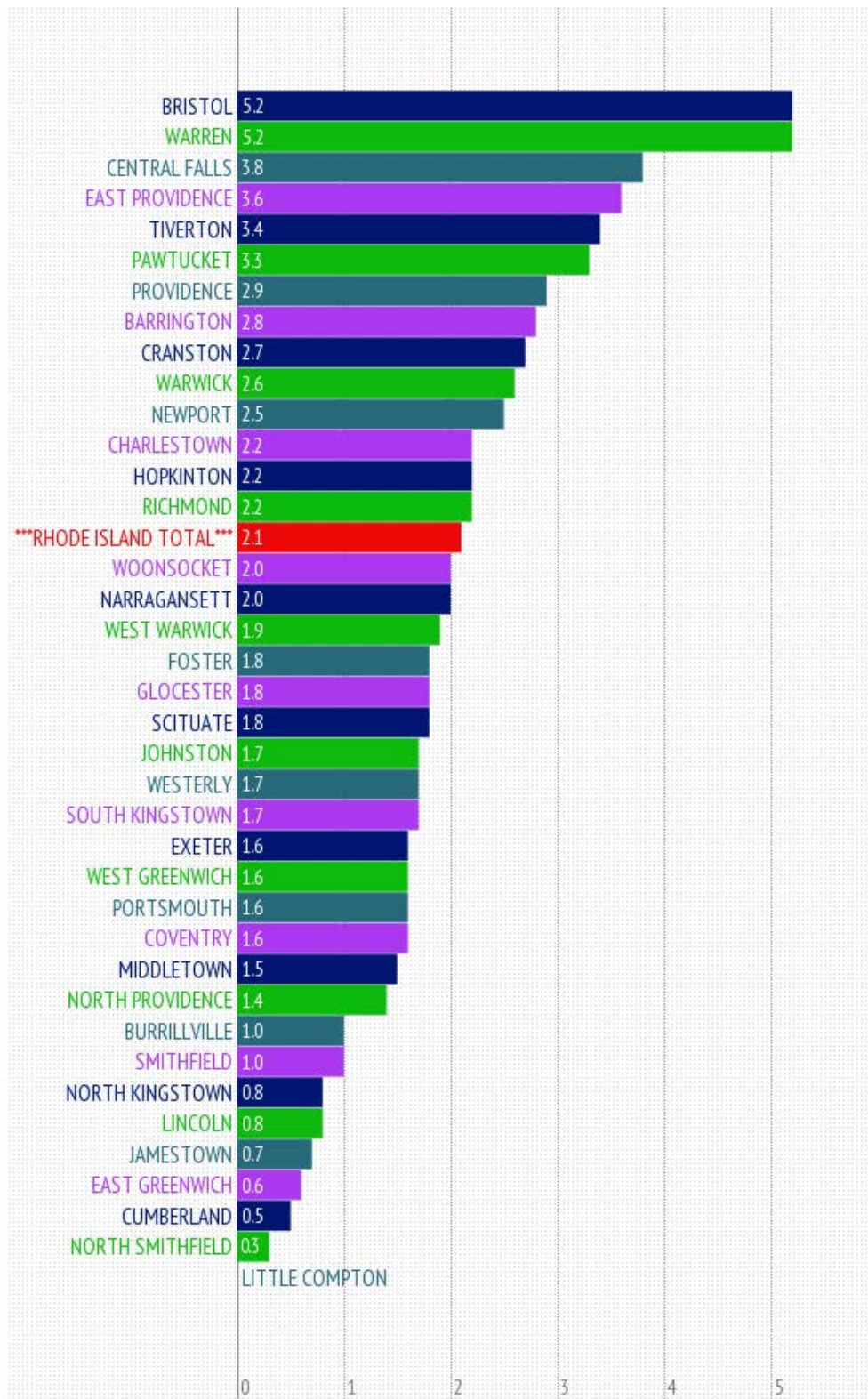


## Middle School Current Alcohol Use 2012-2013



The percent of middle school students in the 2012-2013 school year that responded “yes” to the question, “Have you drank alcohol 1 or more times in the past 30 days?”

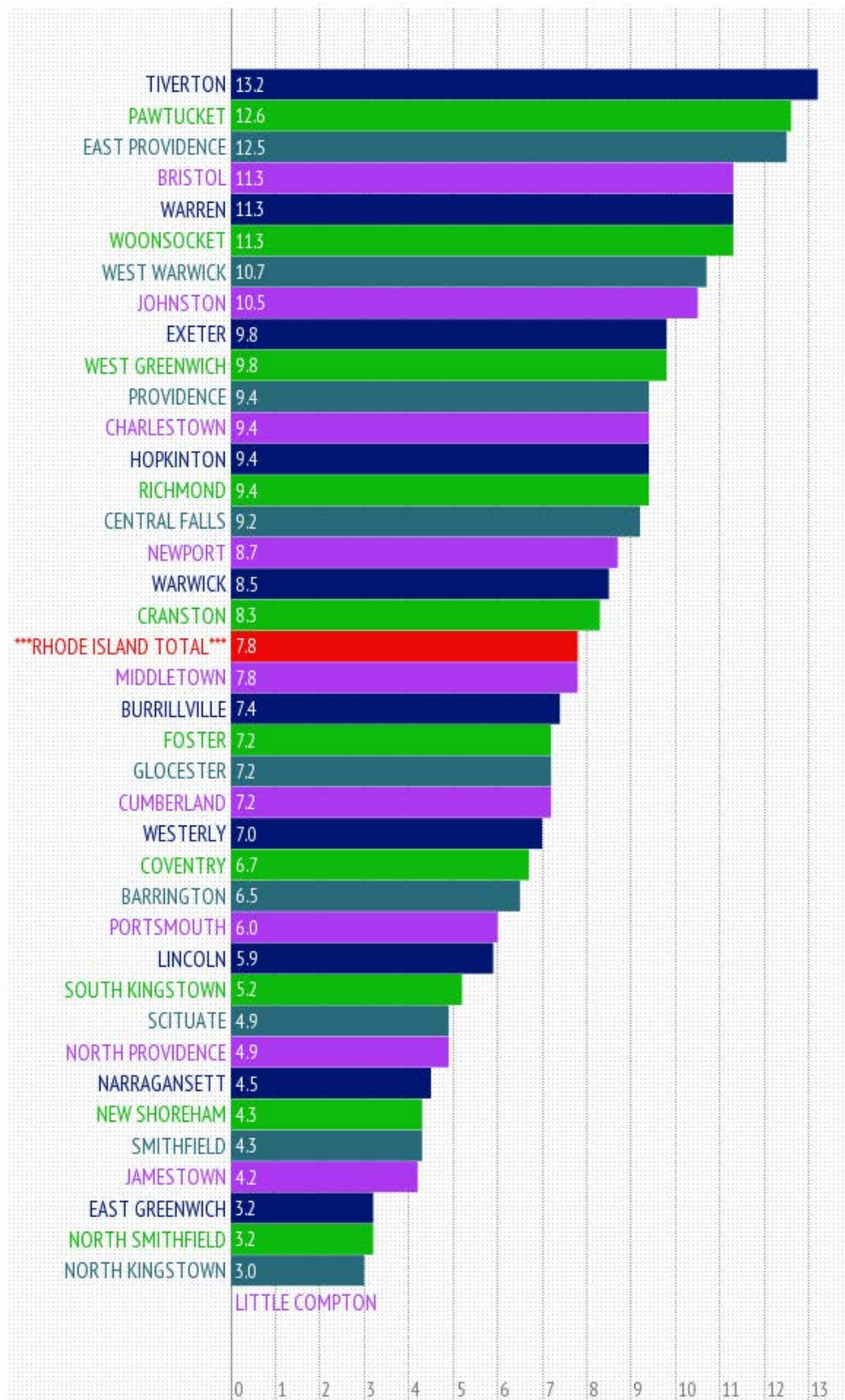

The percent of middle school students in the 2012-2013 school year that responded "yes" to the question, "Have you drank alcohol 6 or more times in the past 30 days?"

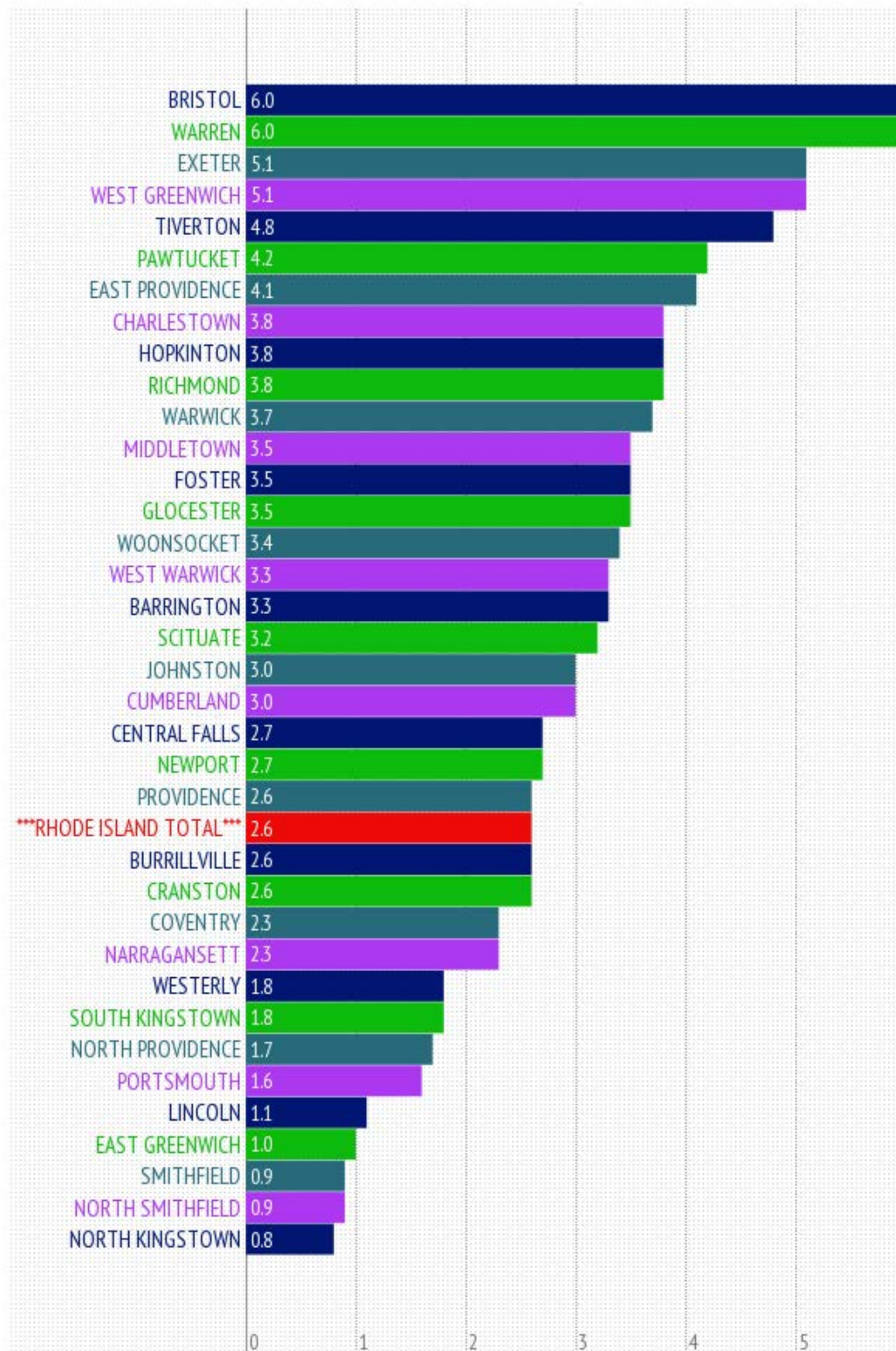


## Middle School Ever Smoked 2012-2013



The percent of middle school students in the 2012-2013 school year that responded "yes" to the question, "Have you ever smoked a cigarette, even one or two puffs?"

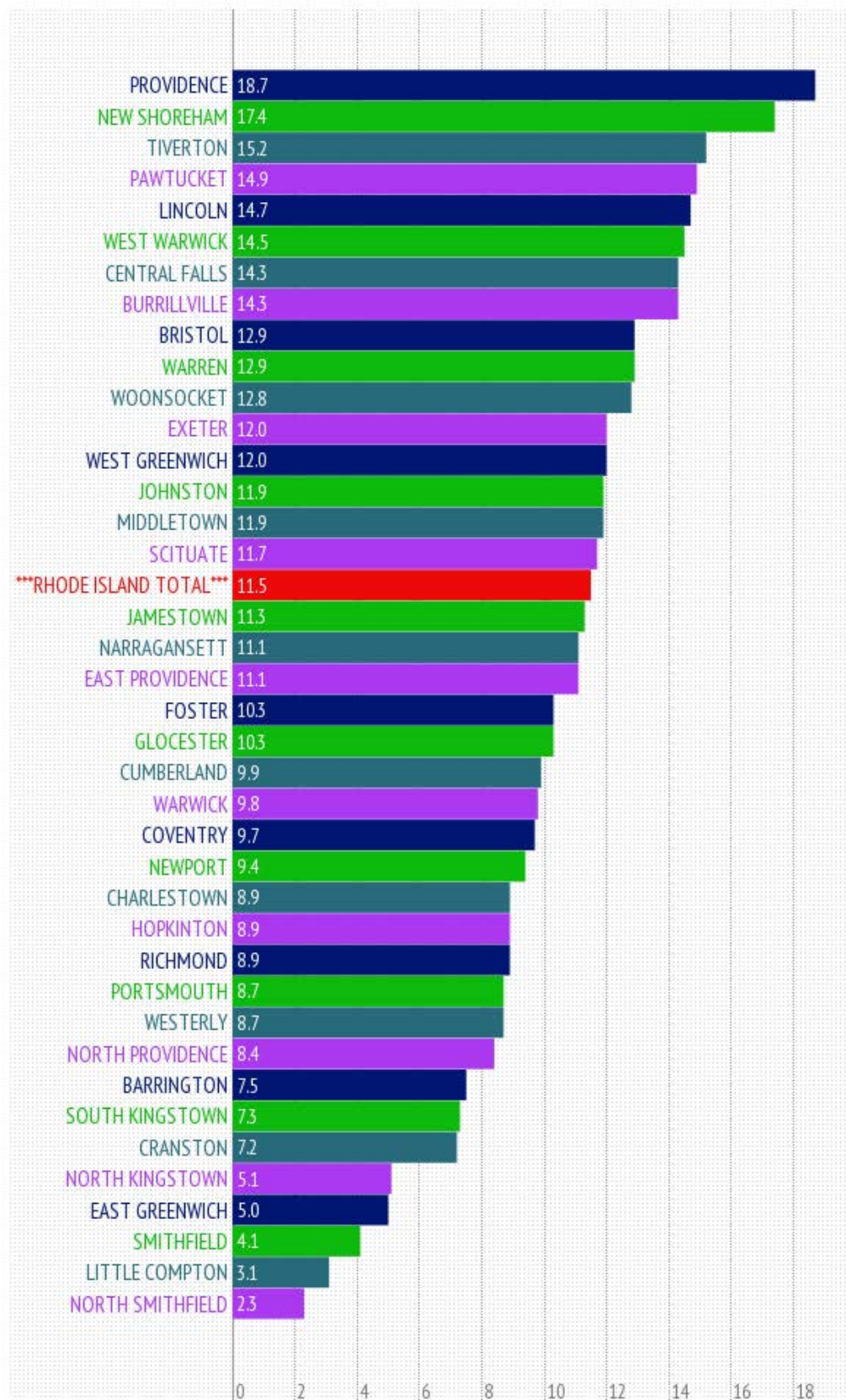

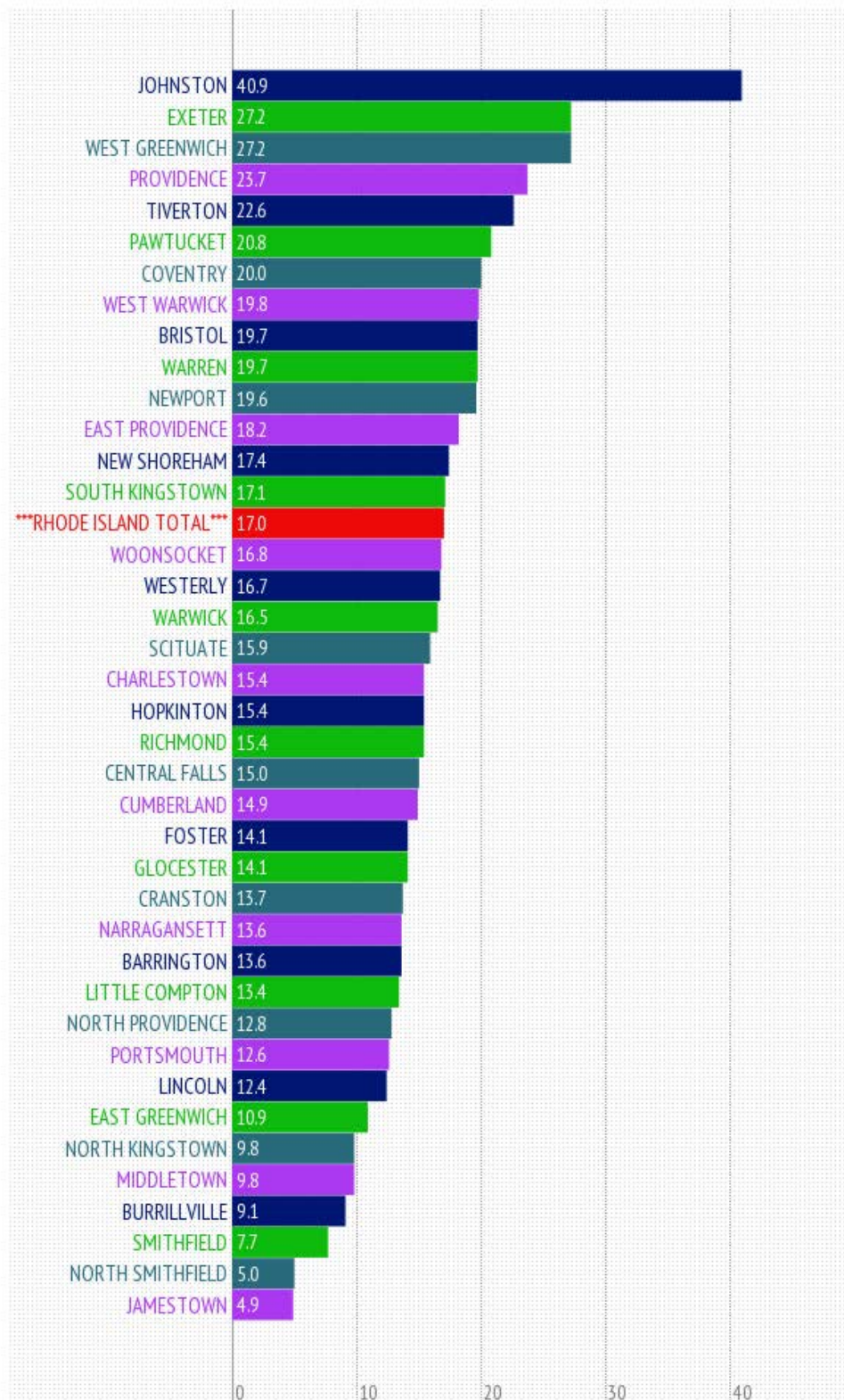

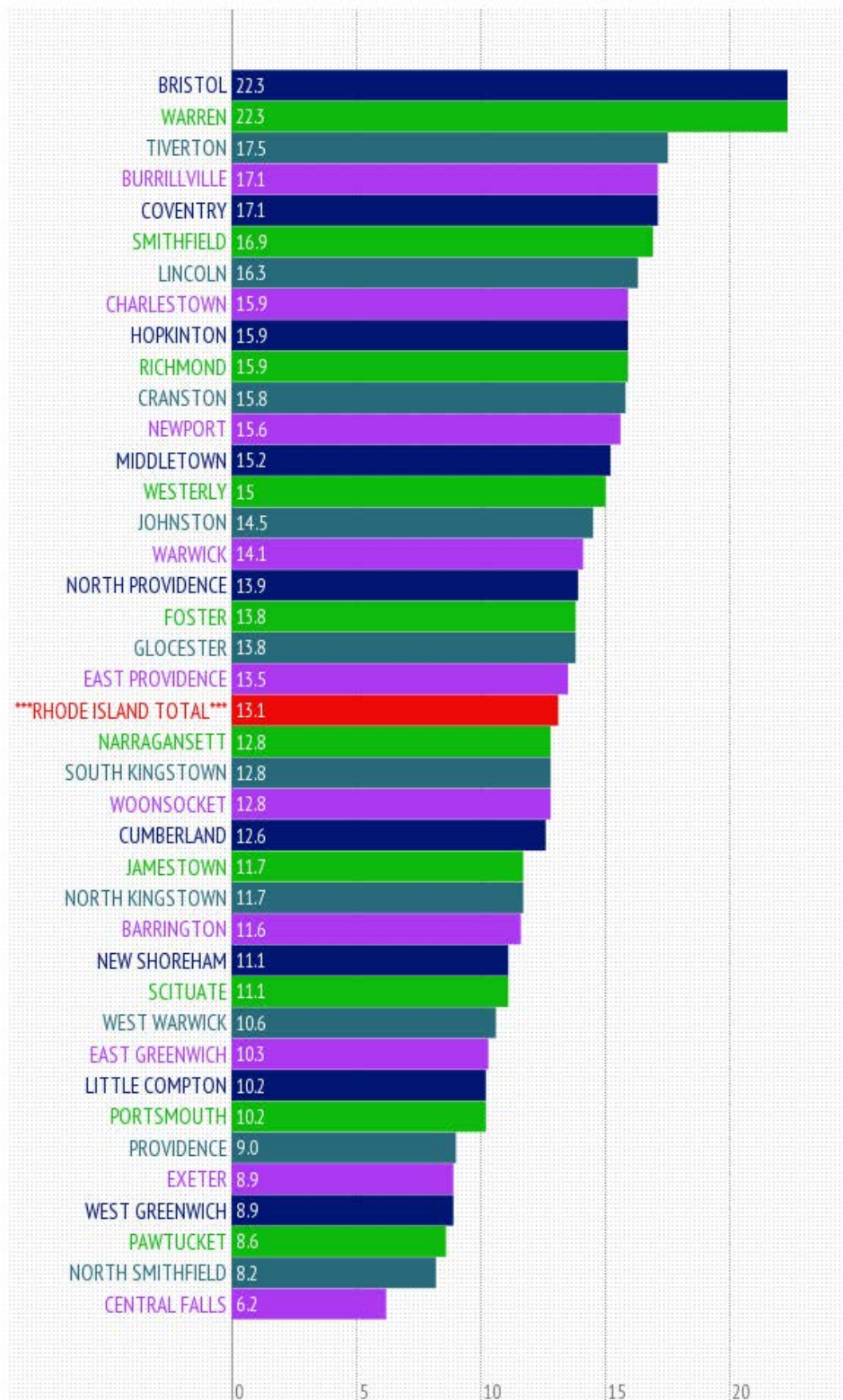

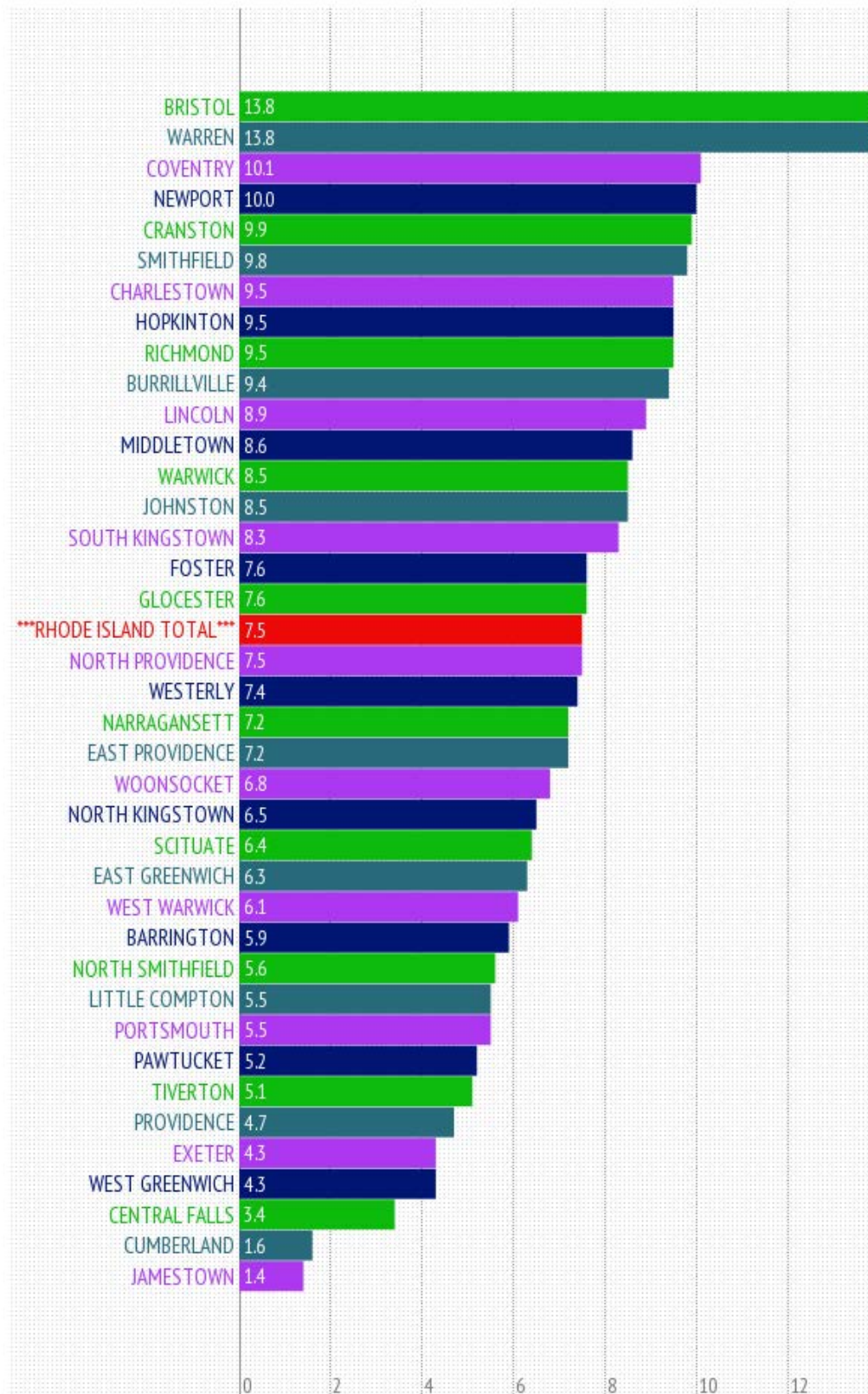

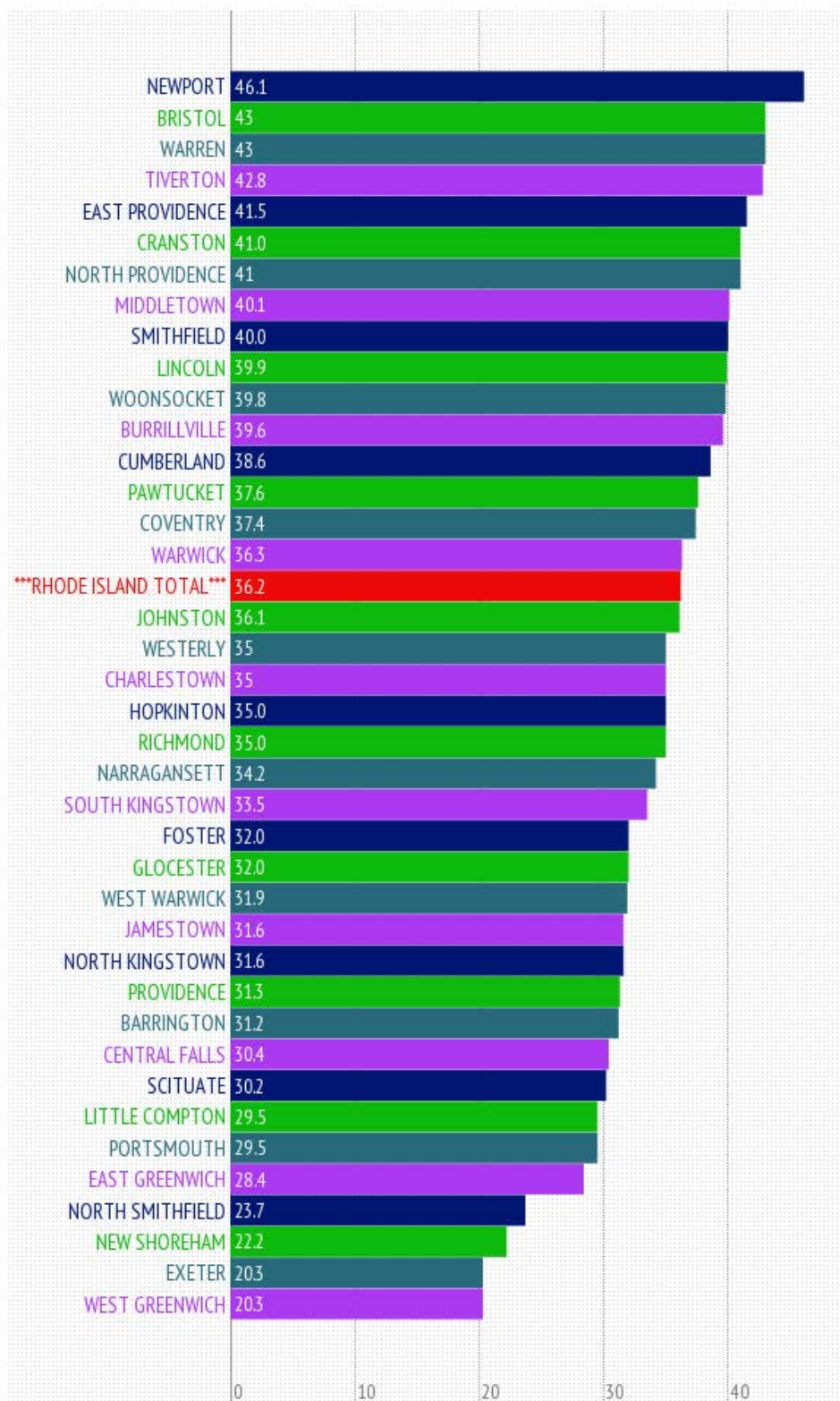

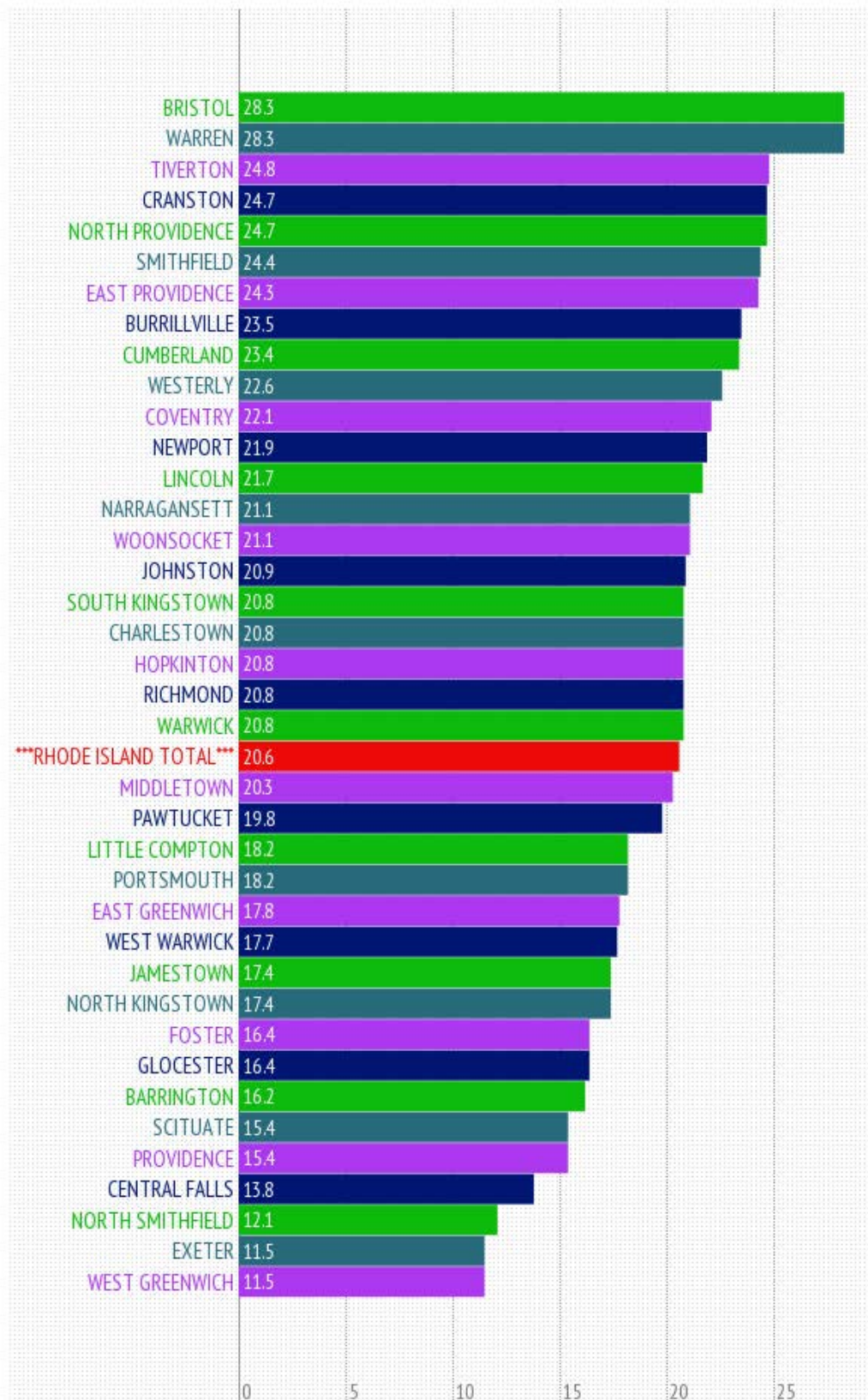

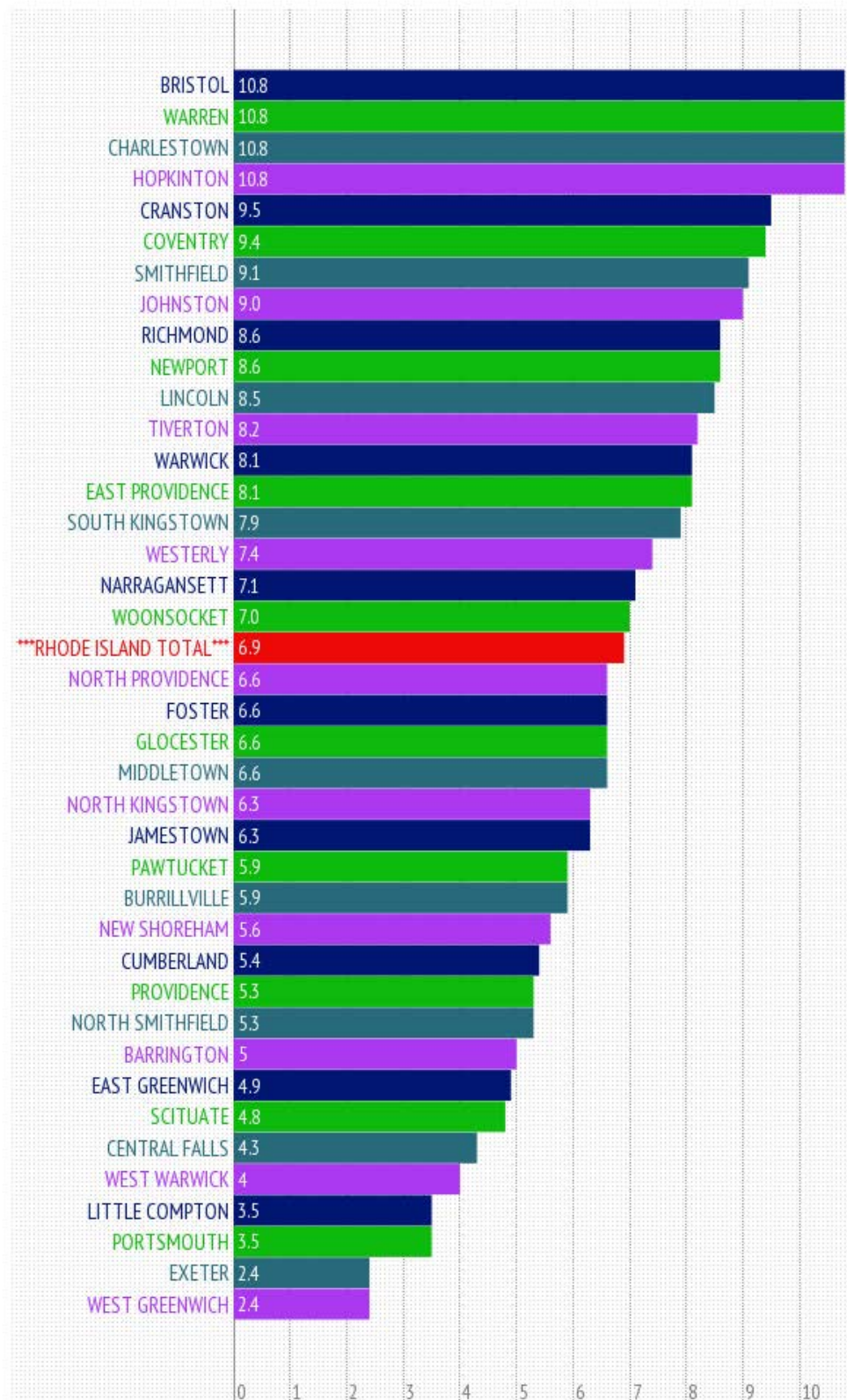

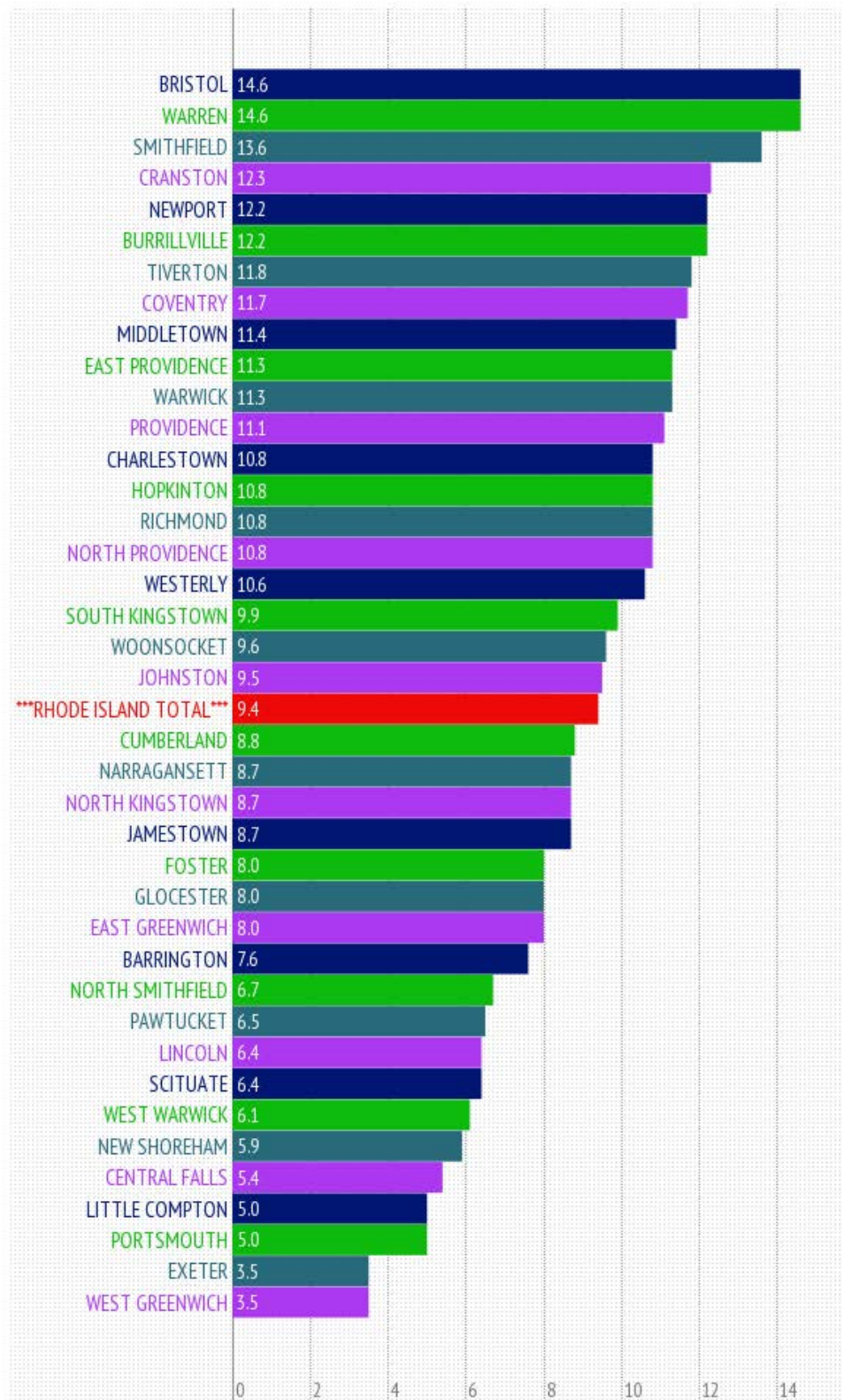

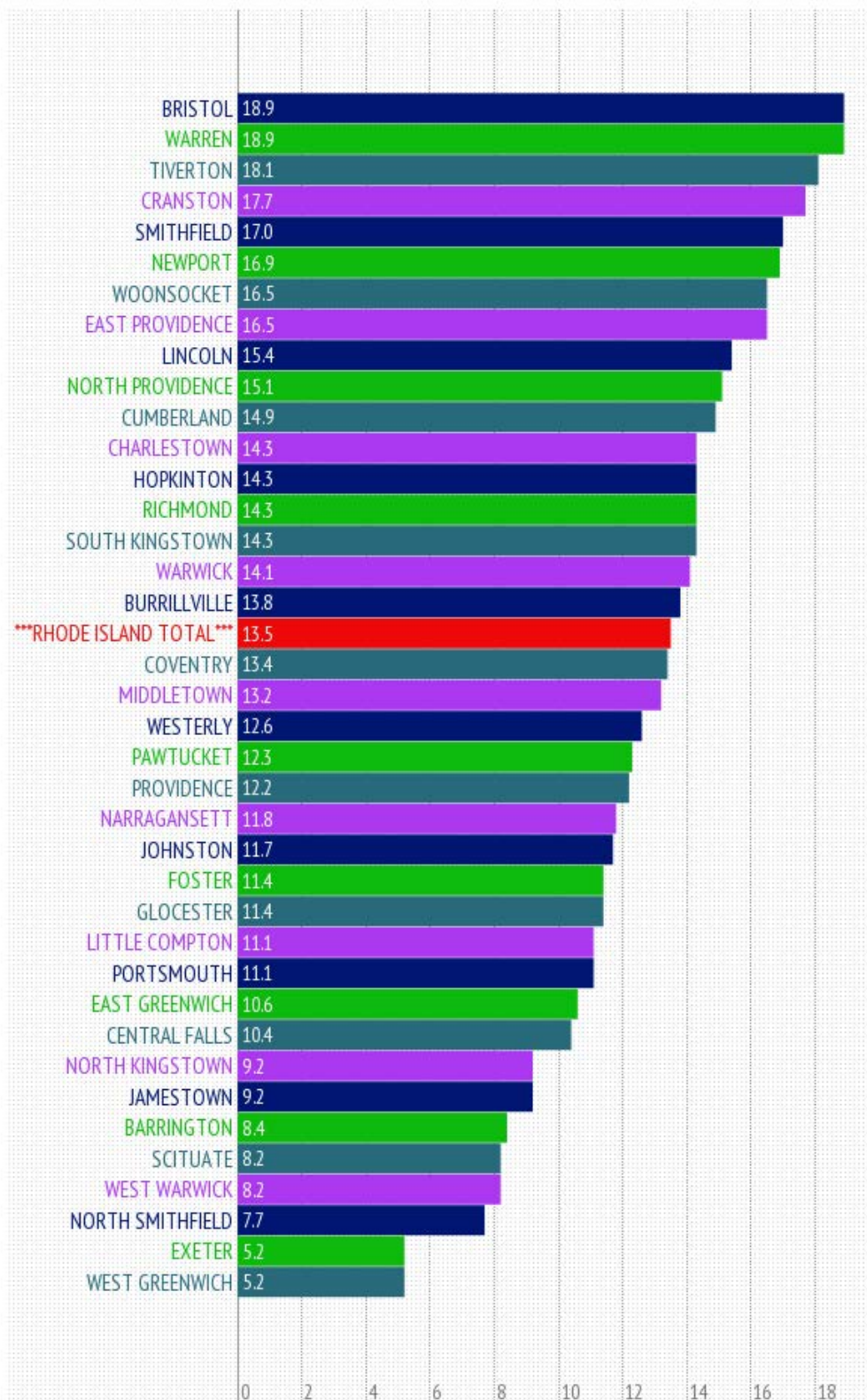

The percent of high school students in the 2012-2013 school year that responded "yes" to the question, "Have you tried other illegal drugs?"

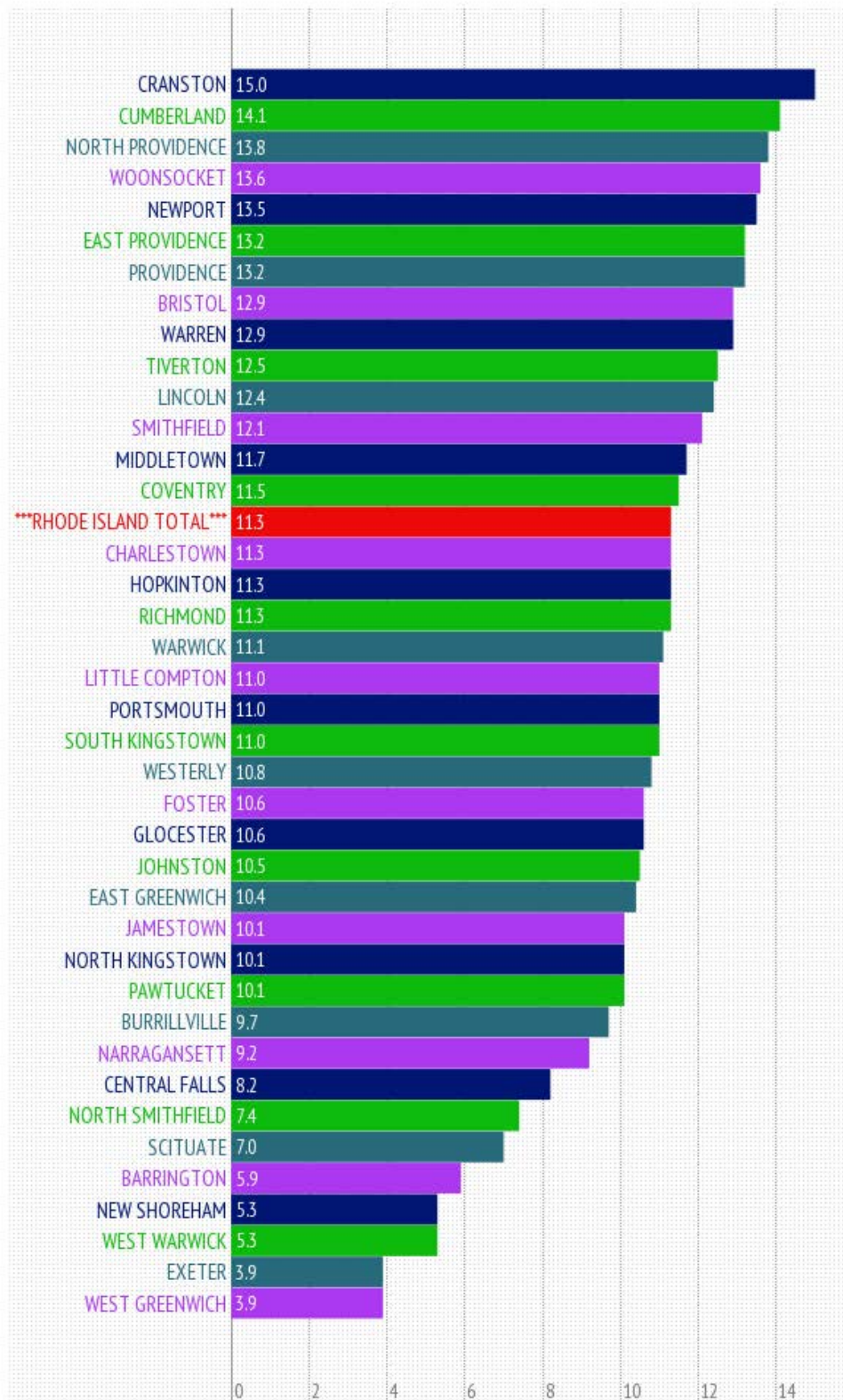


# High School Under Influence of Drugs at School 2012-2013

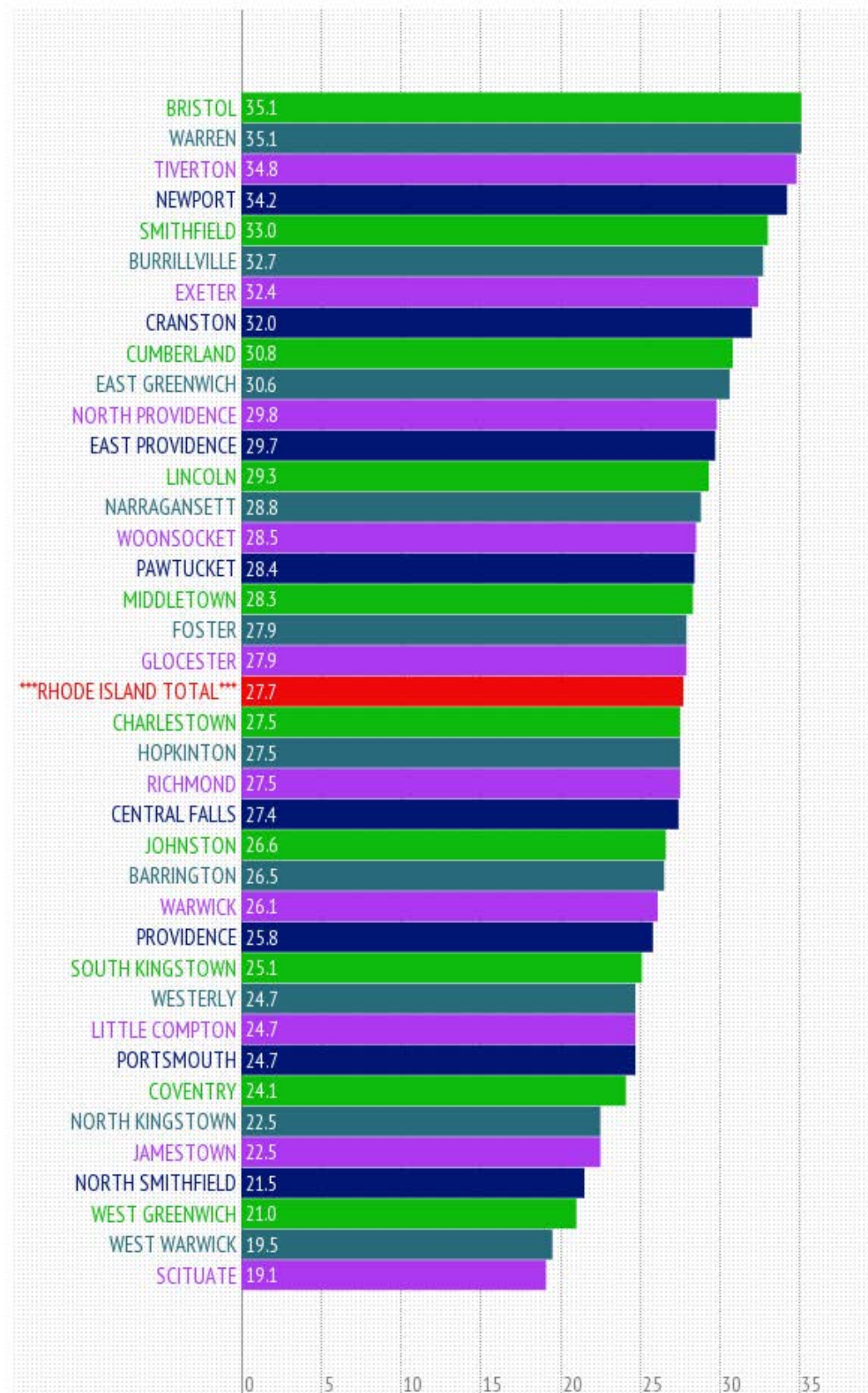

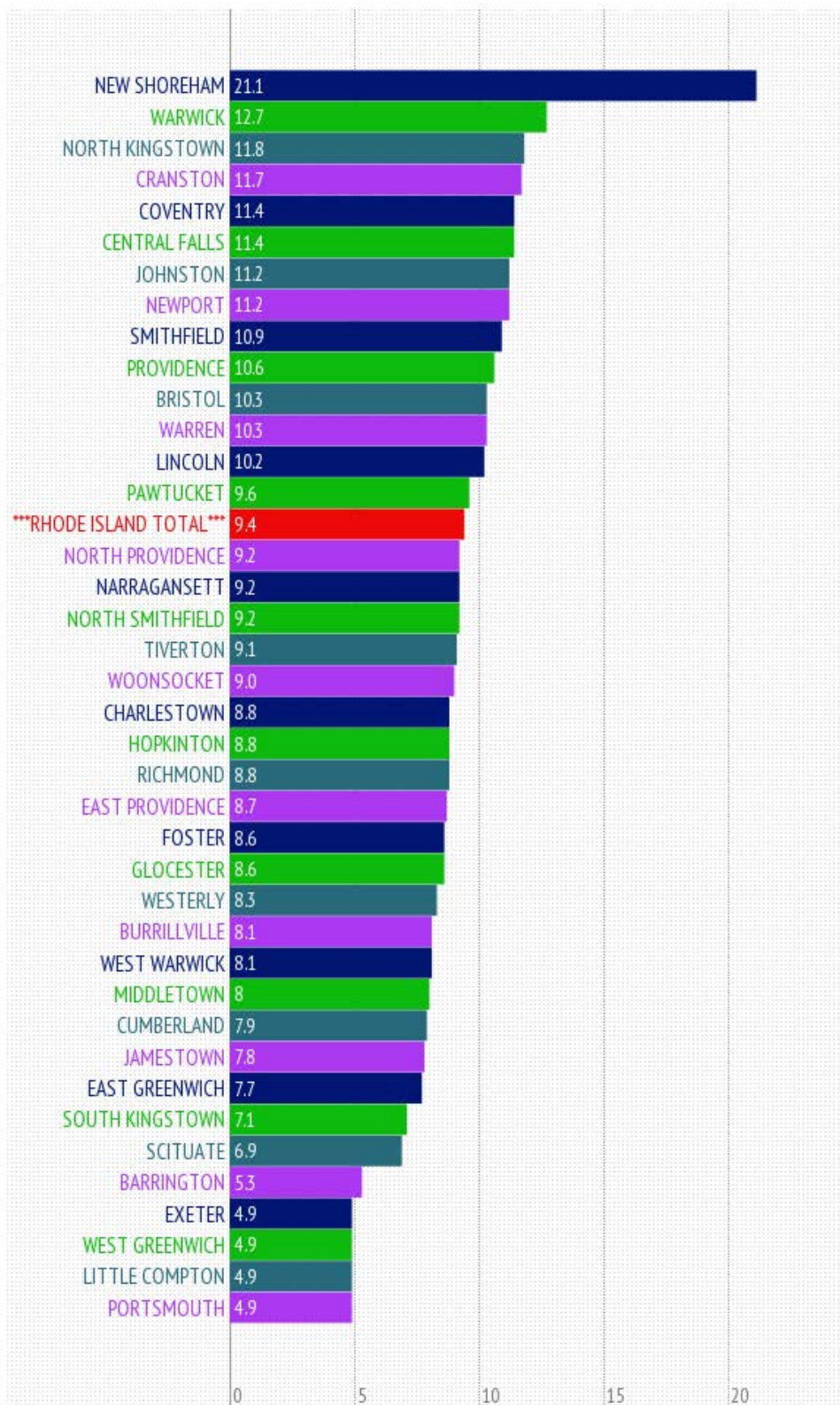

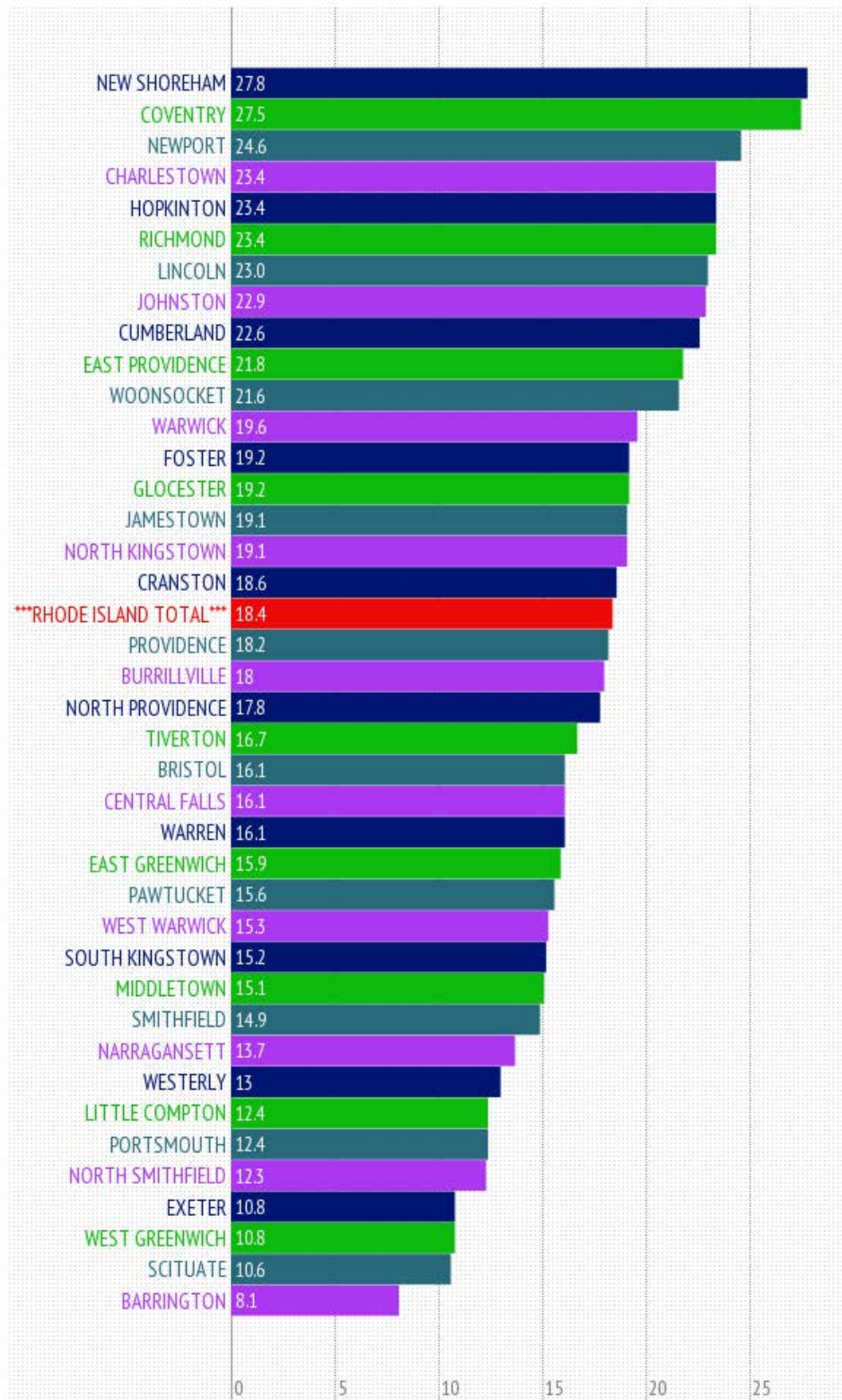

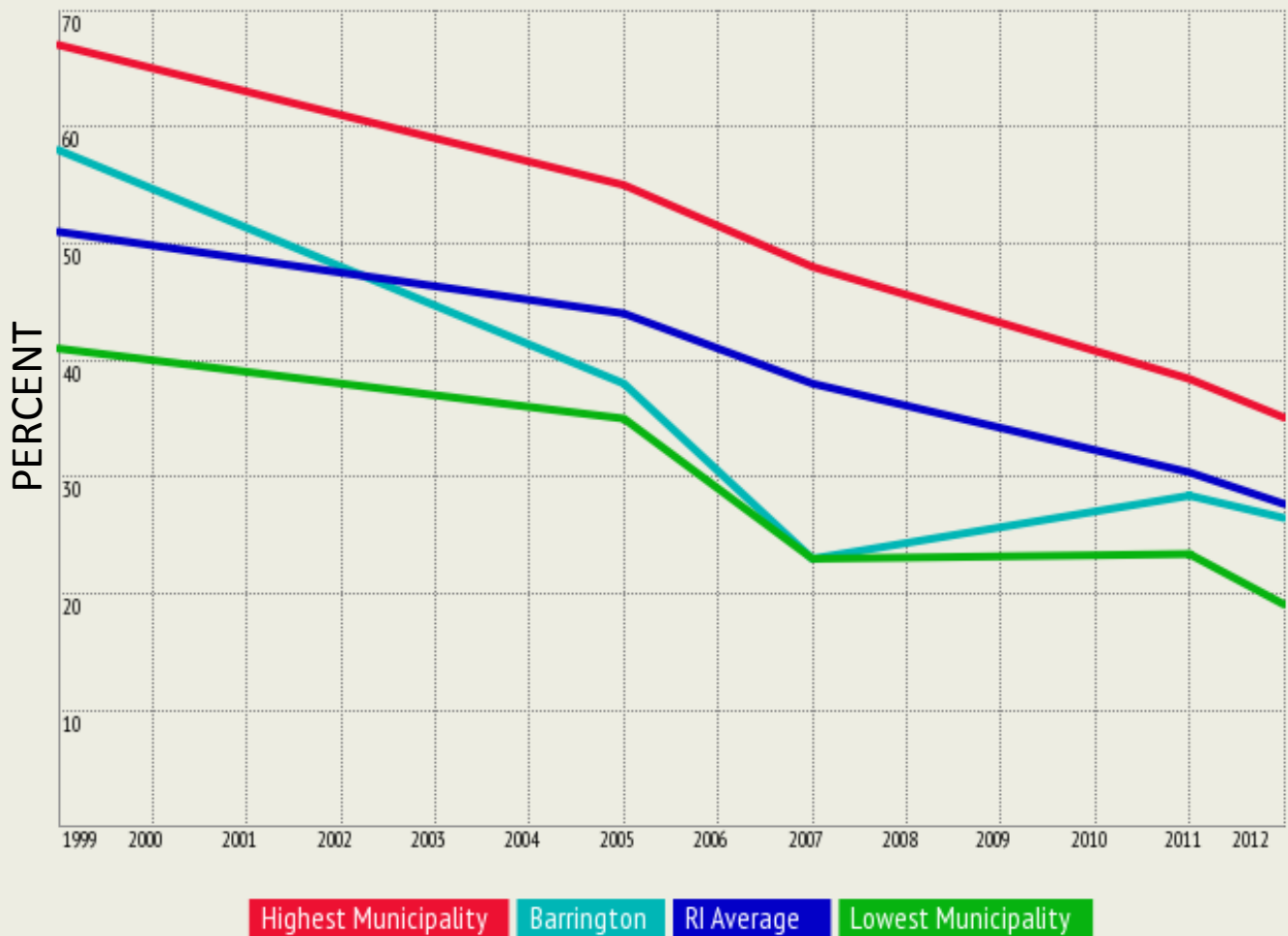

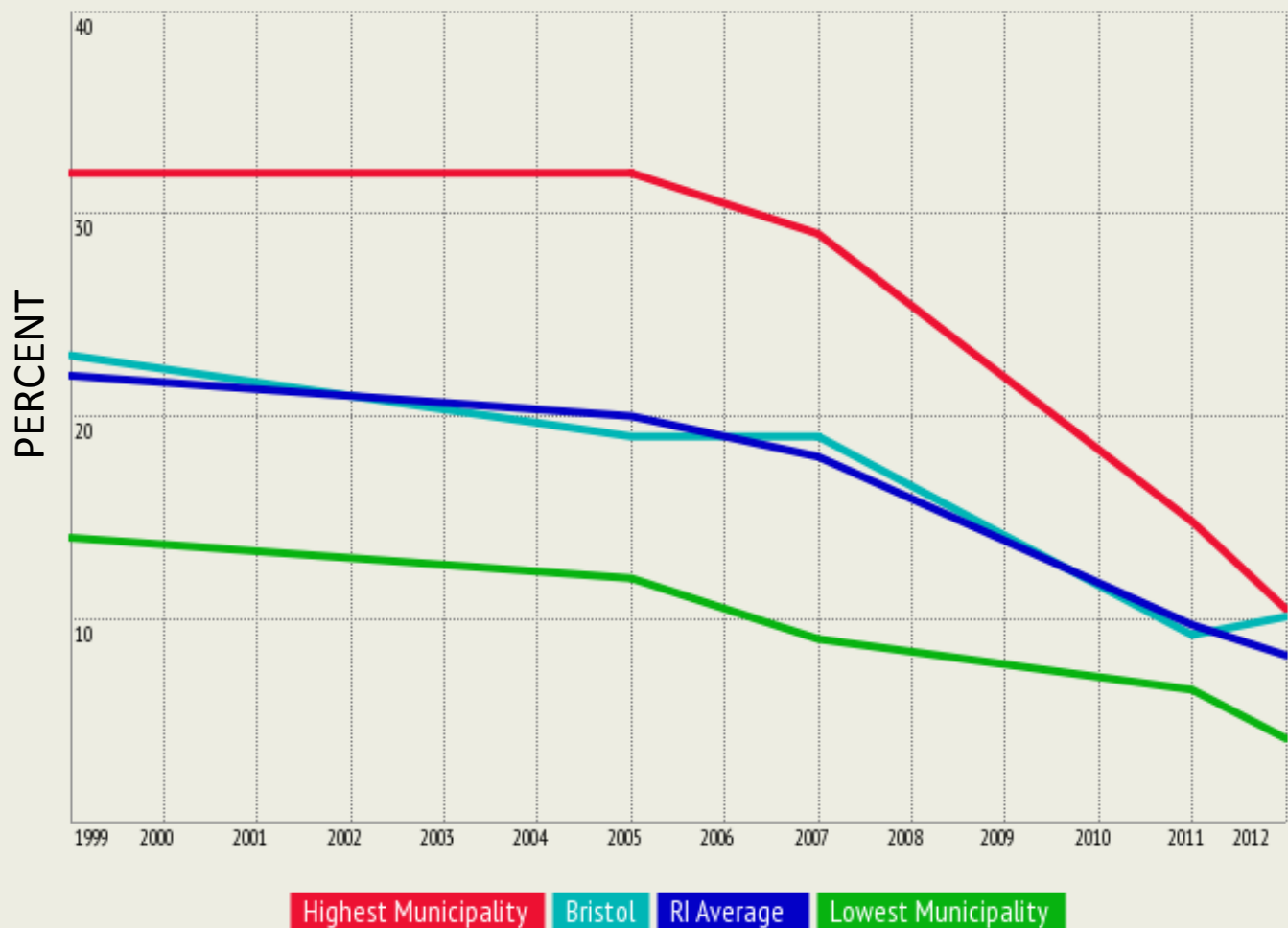

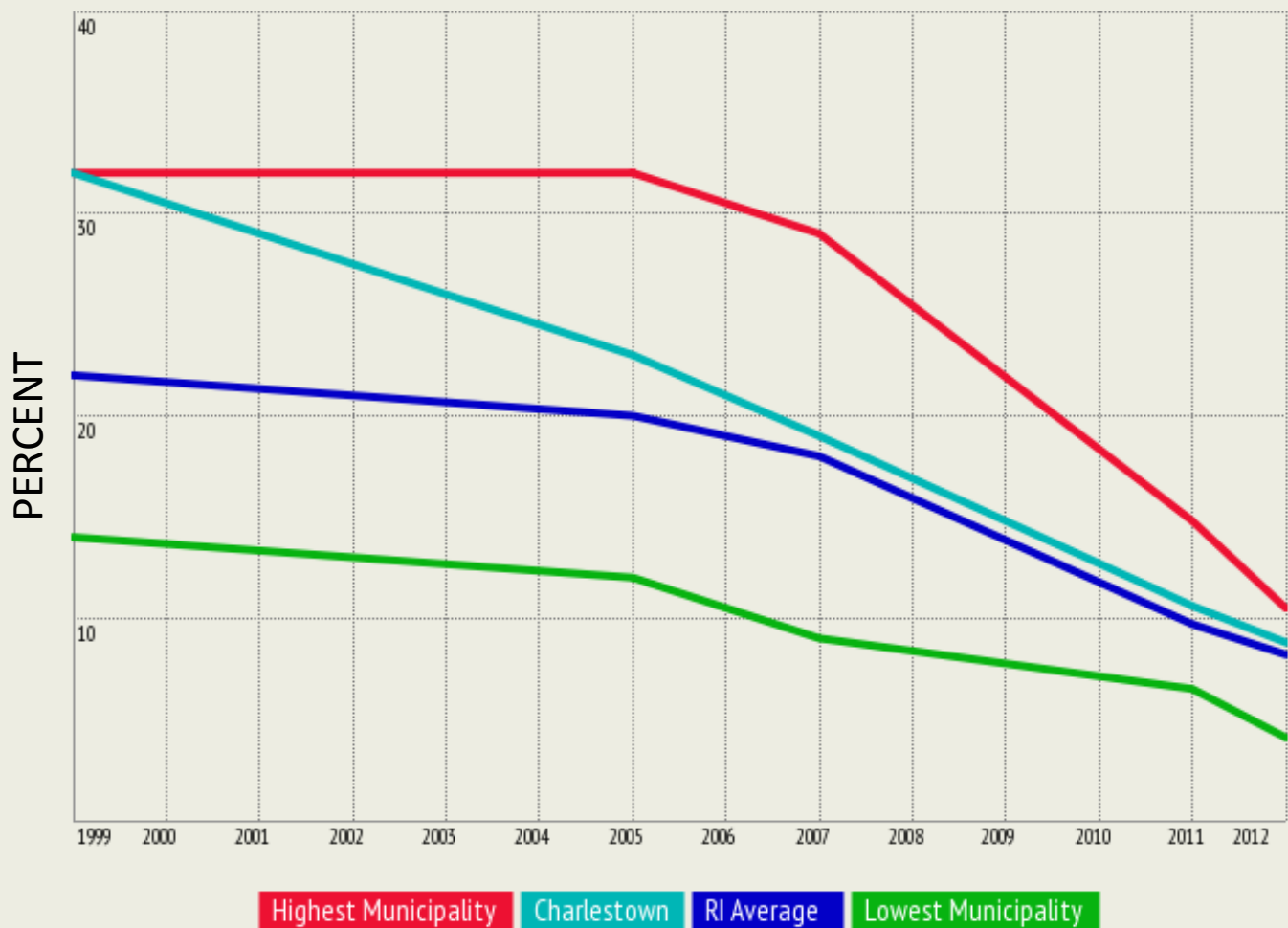


The percent of high school students that reported drinking alcohol 1 or more times in the past 30 days.

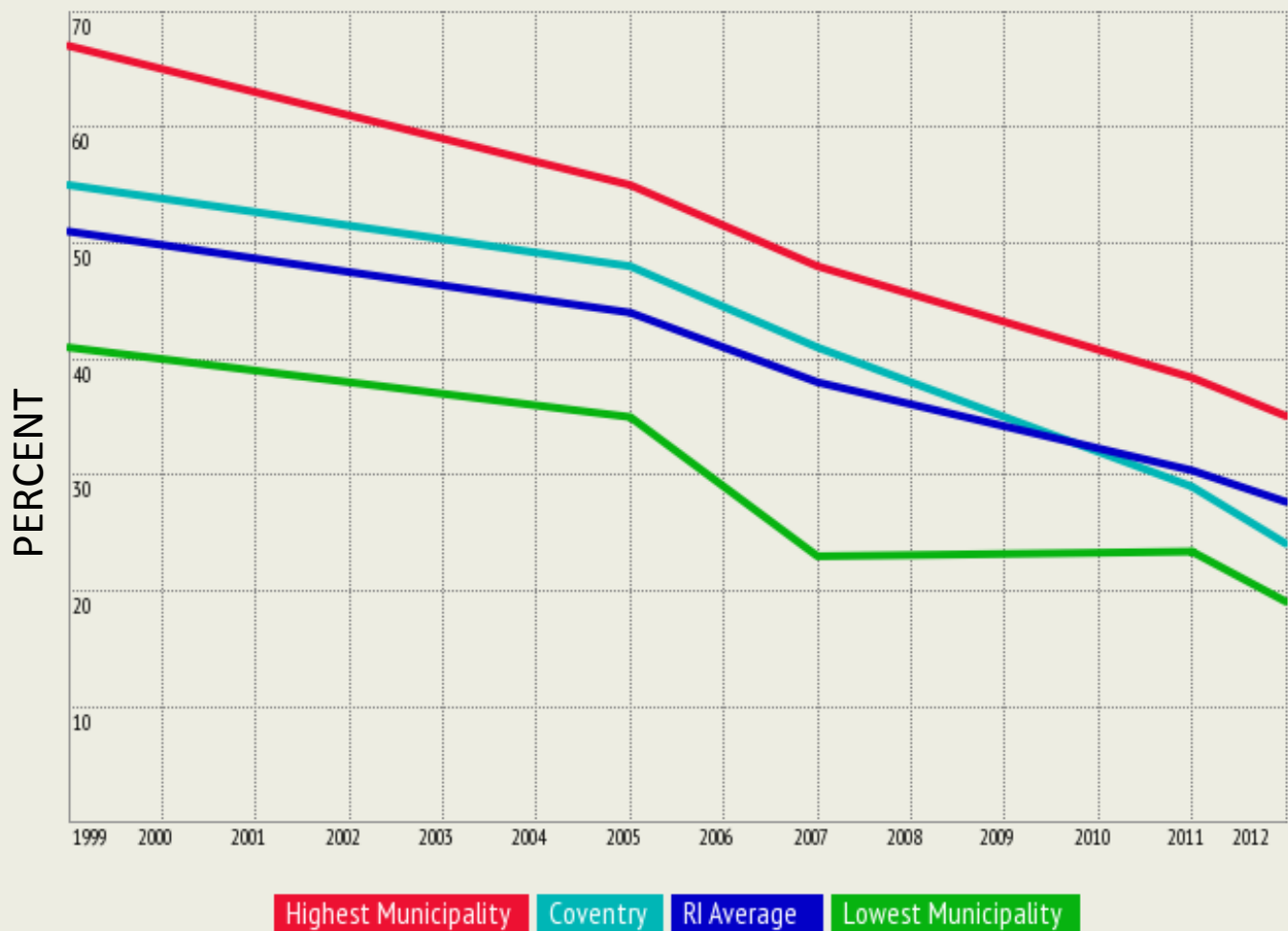

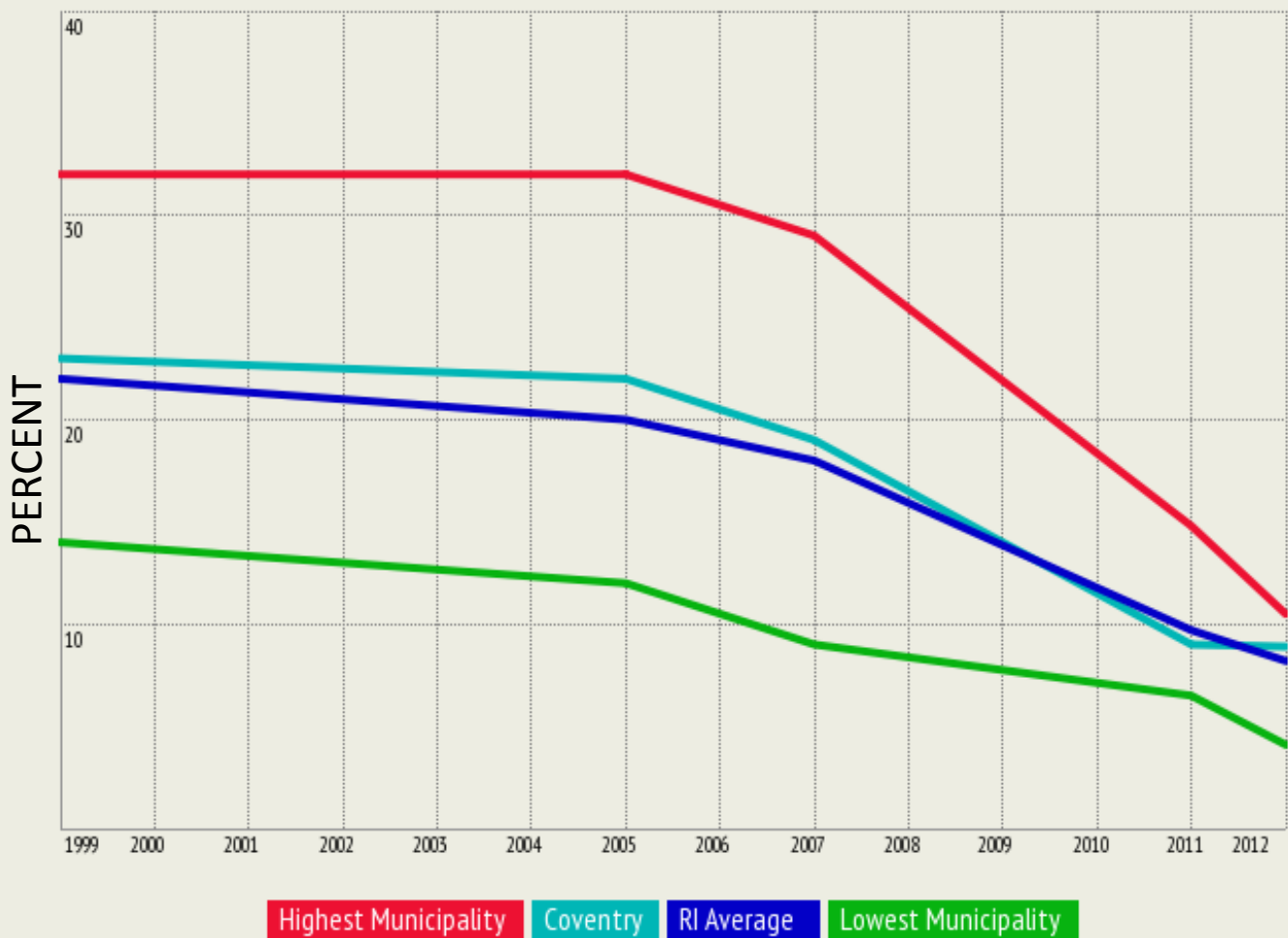

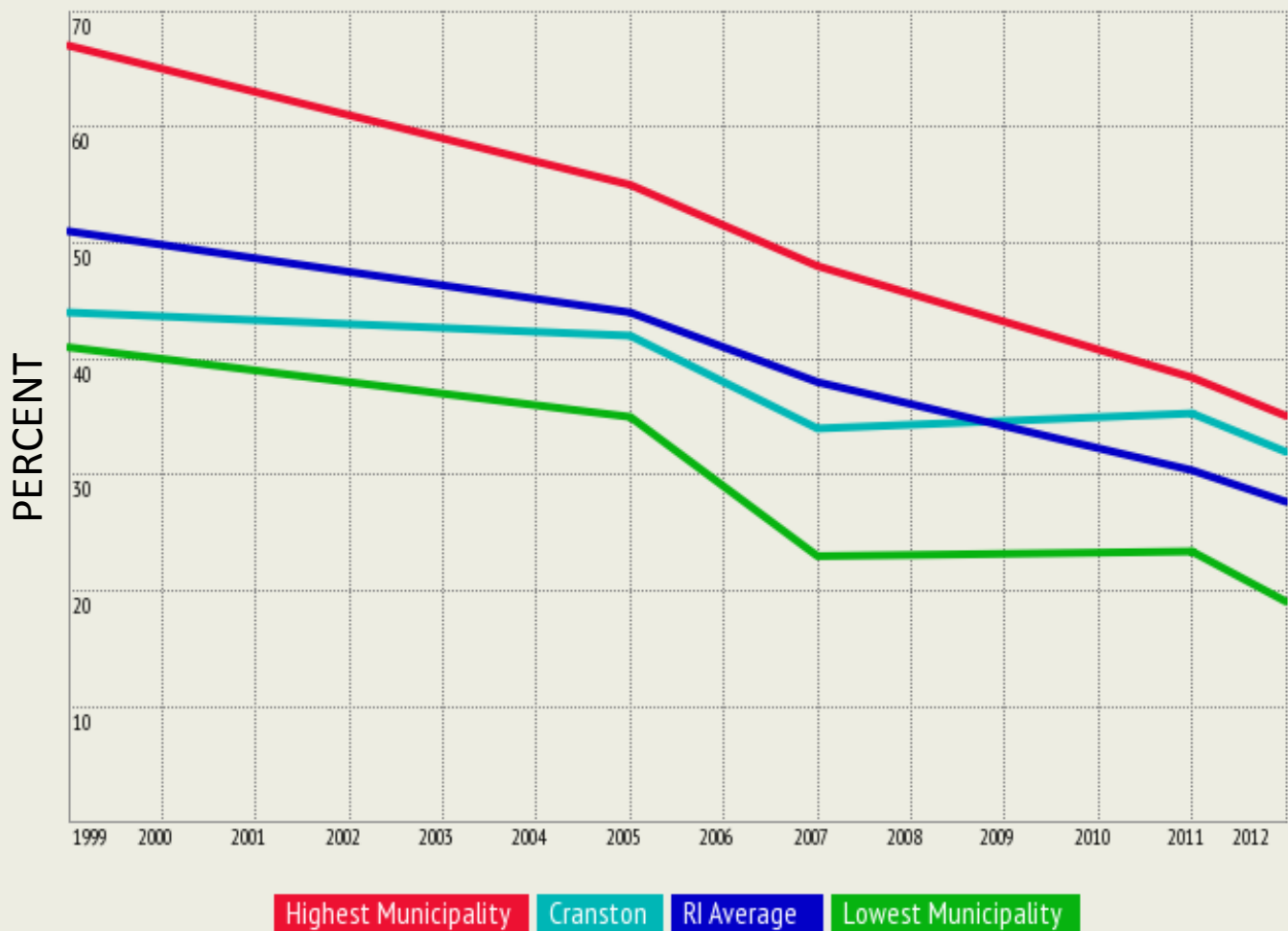

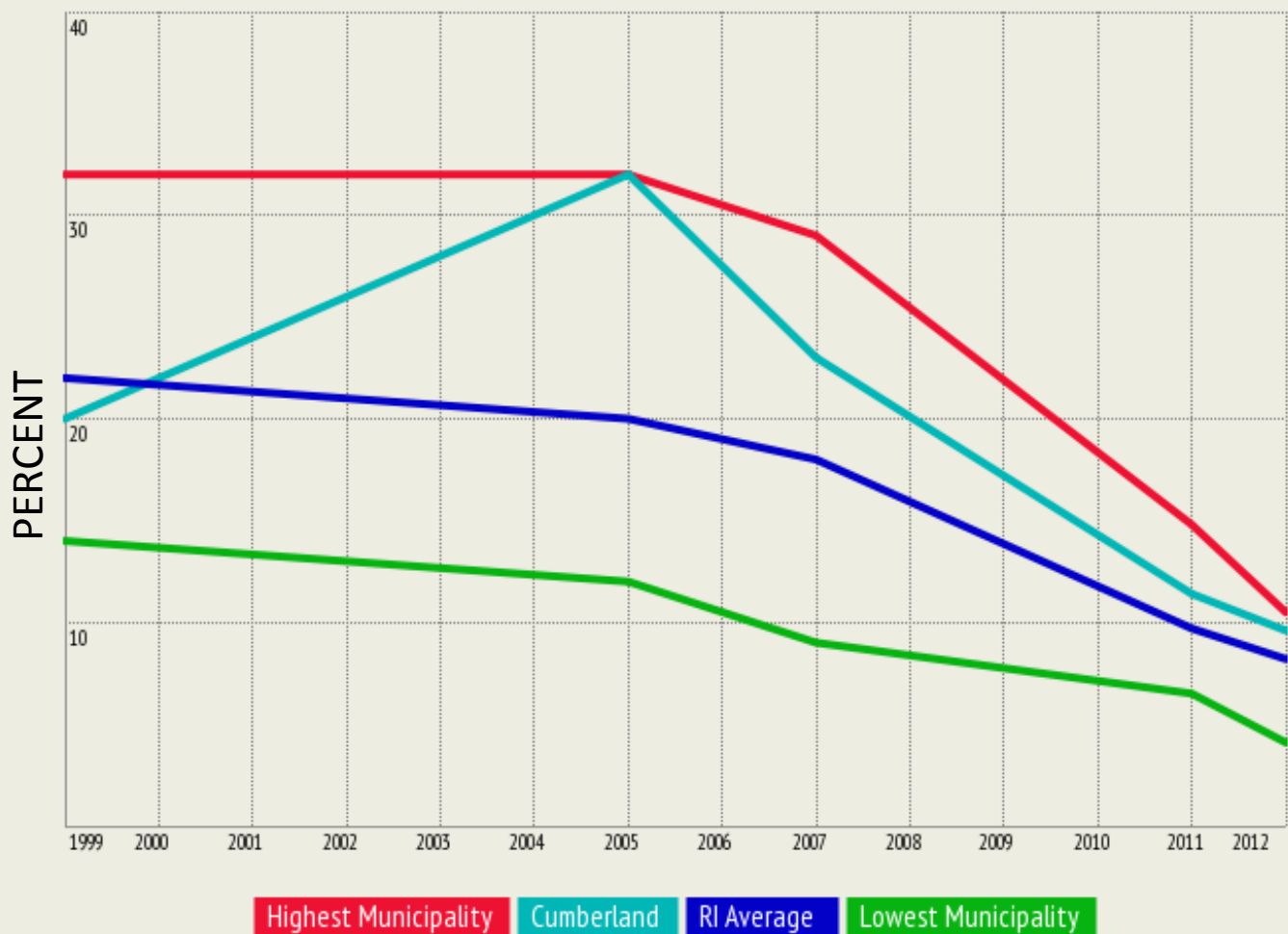

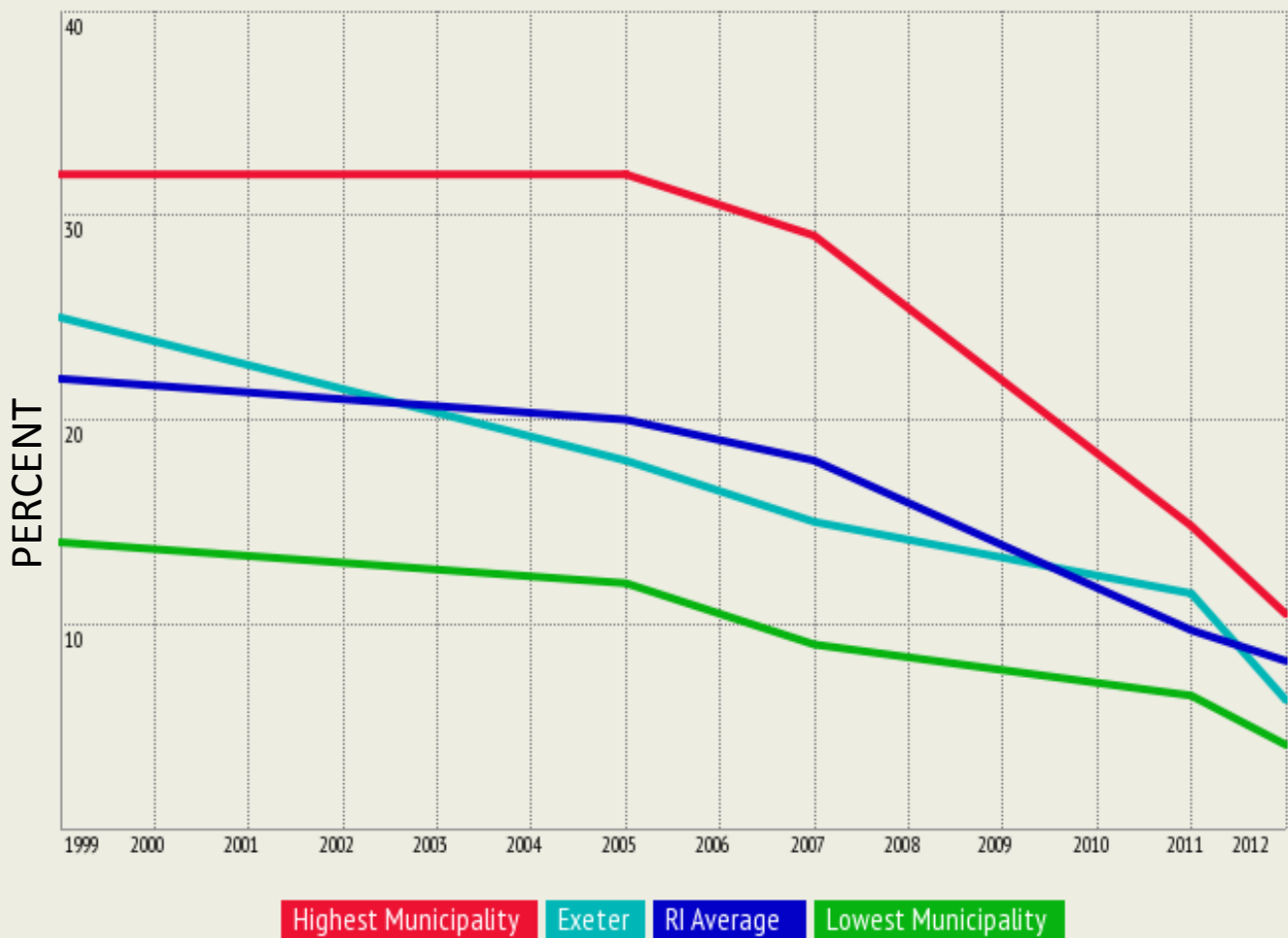


The percent of high school students that reported drinking alcohol 1 or more times in the past 30 days.

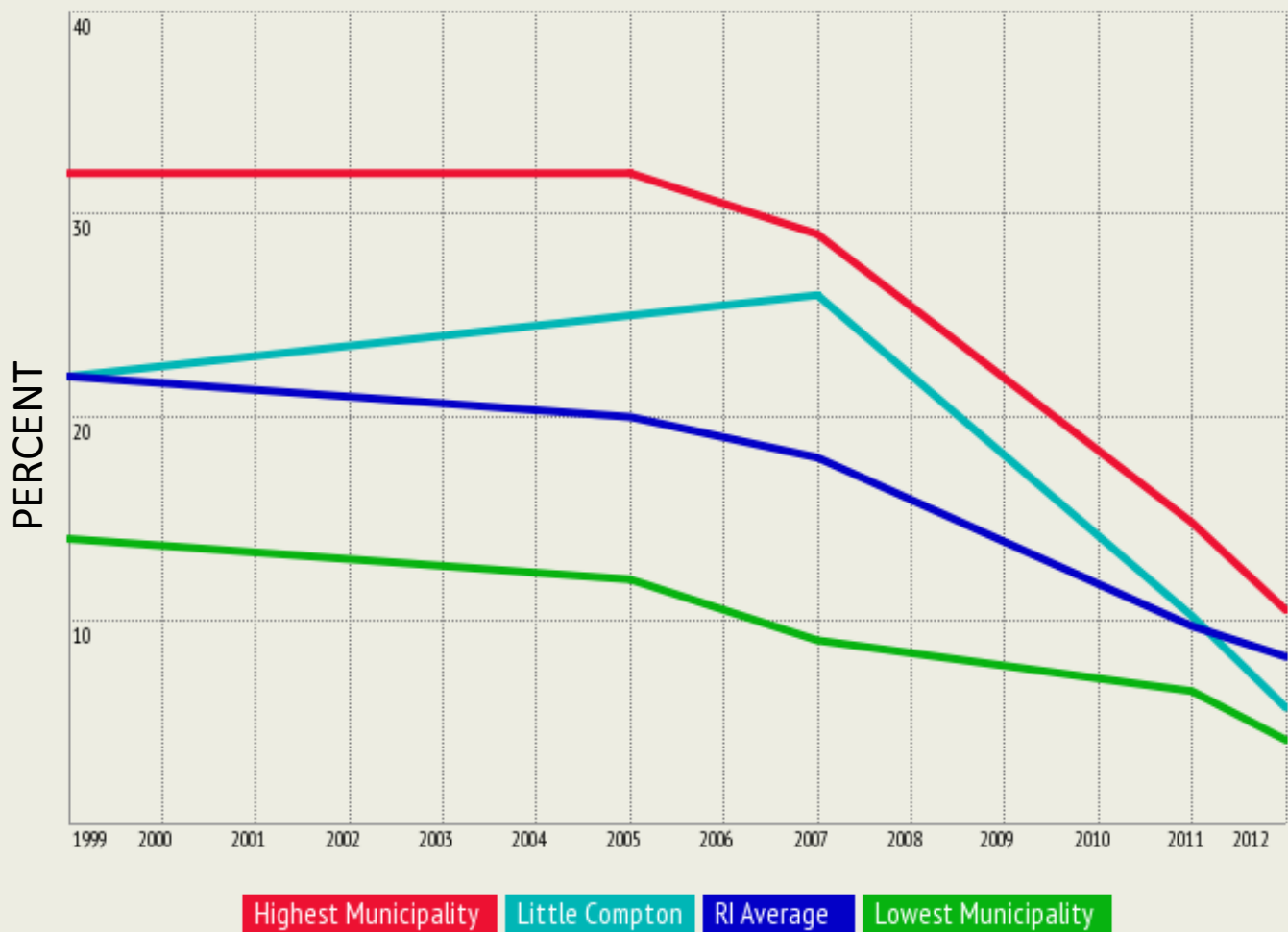

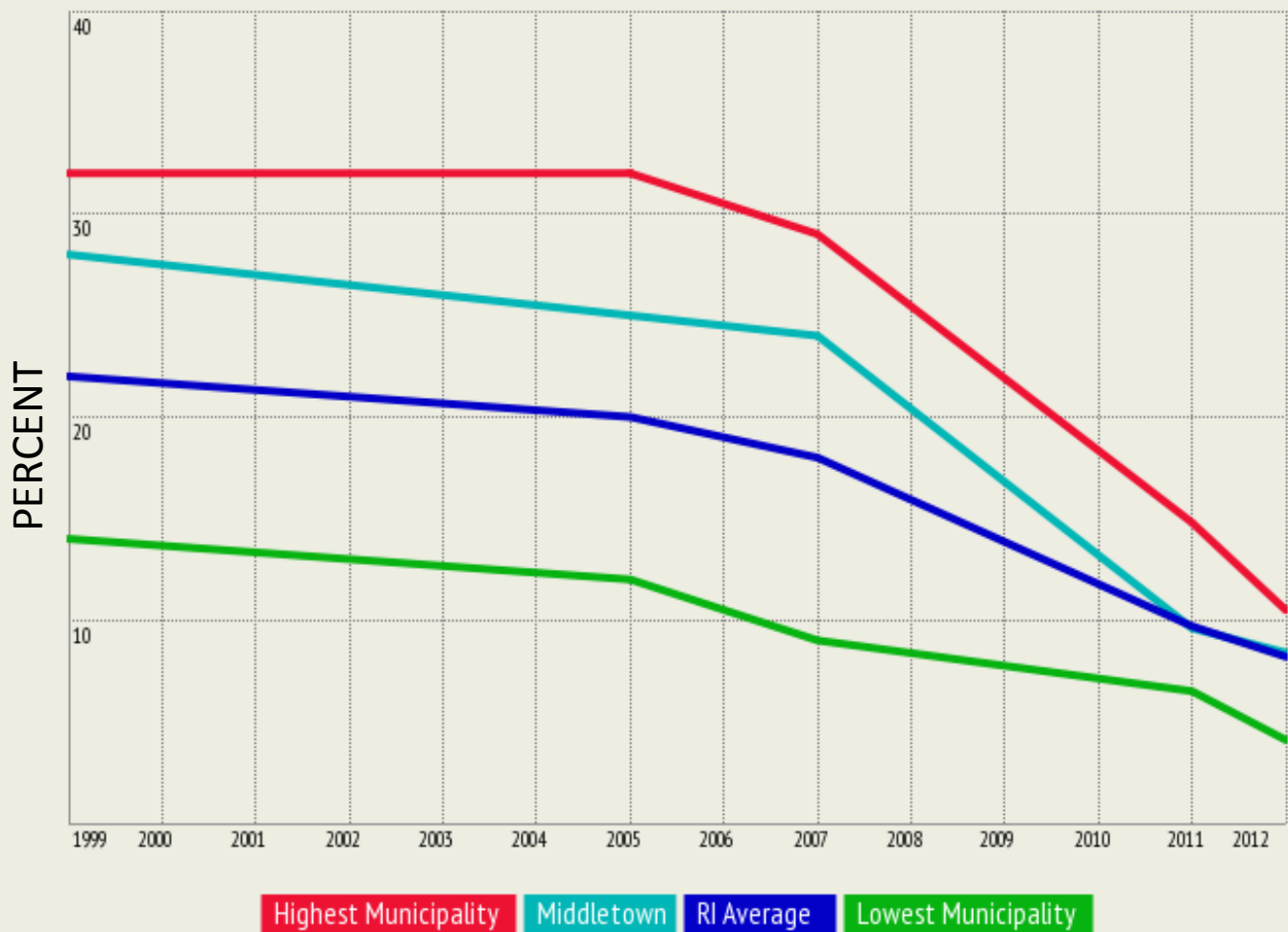


The percent of high school students that reported drinking alcohol 1 or more times in the past 30 days.

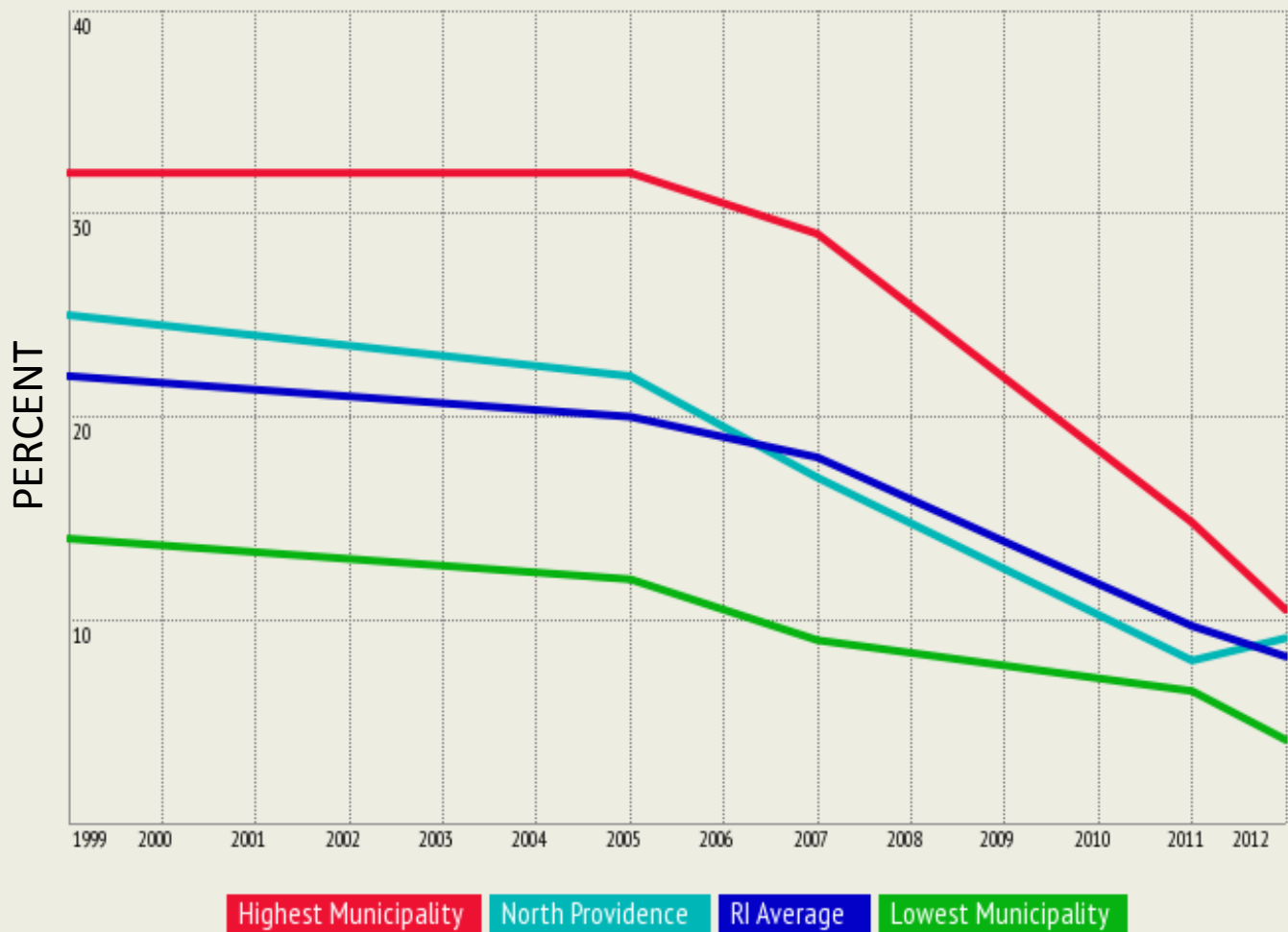

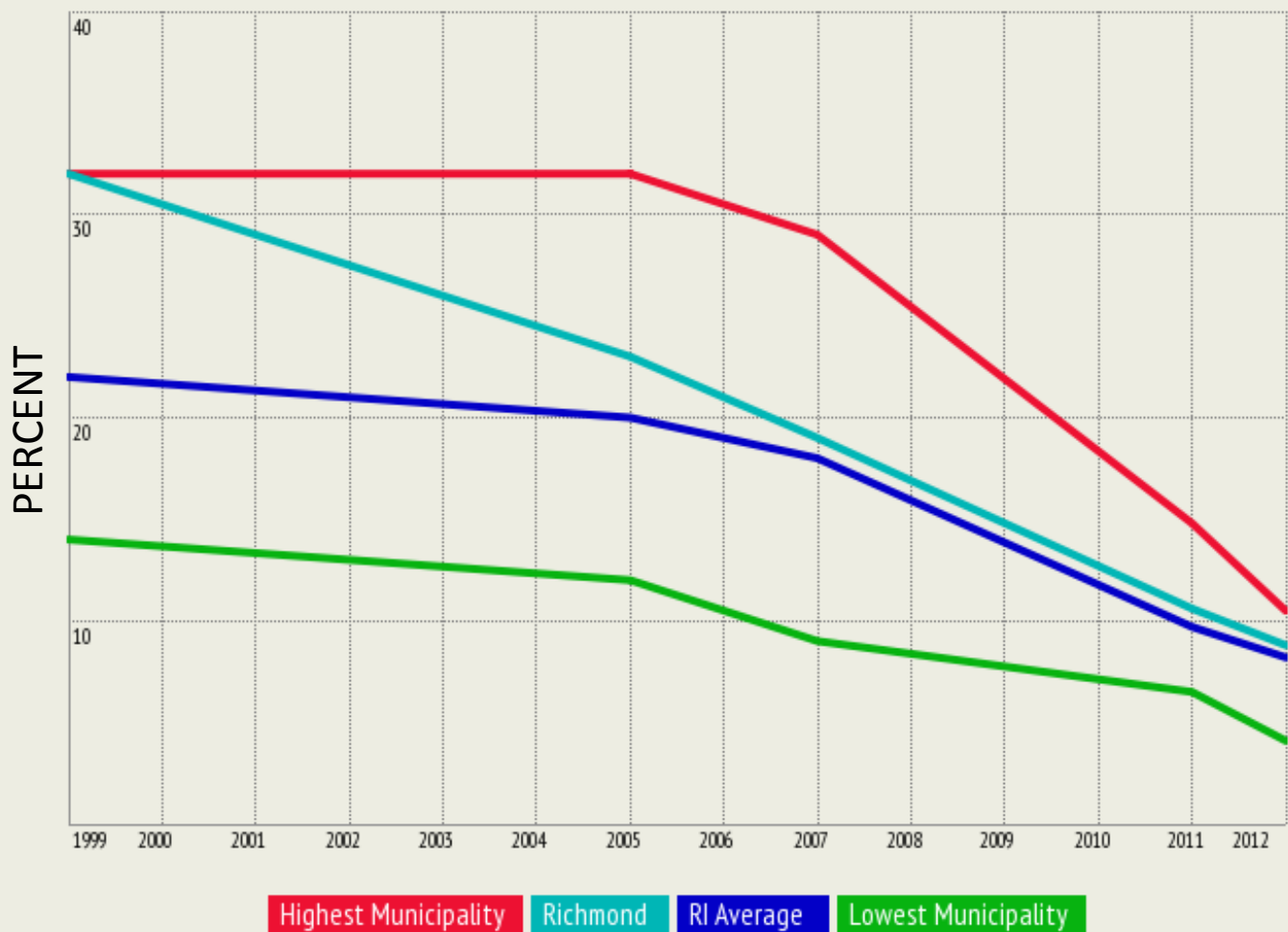
