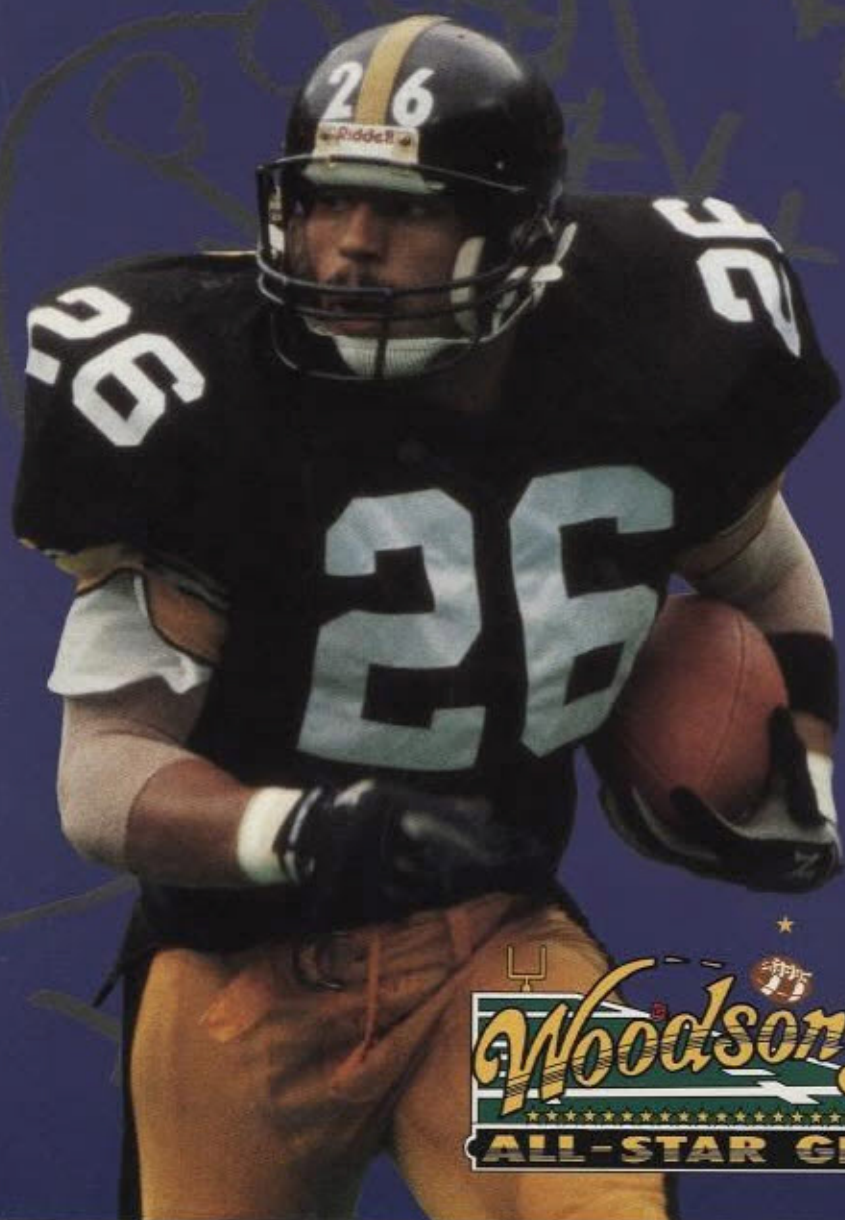

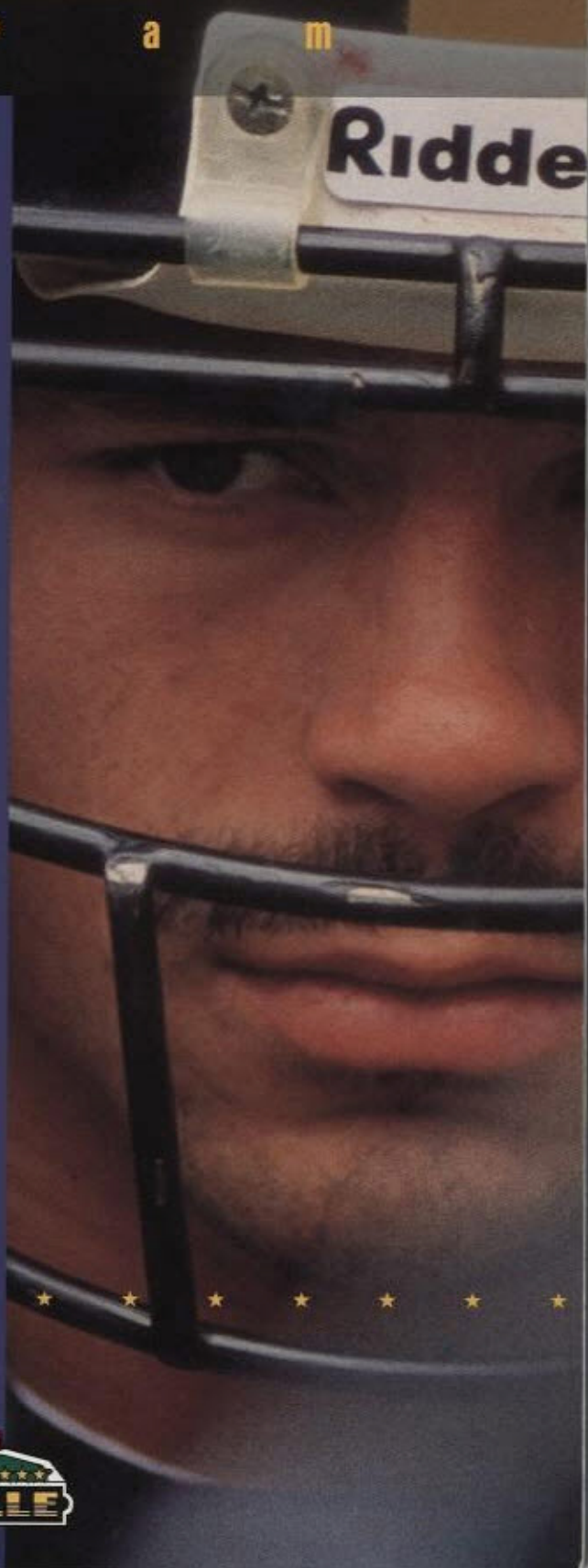

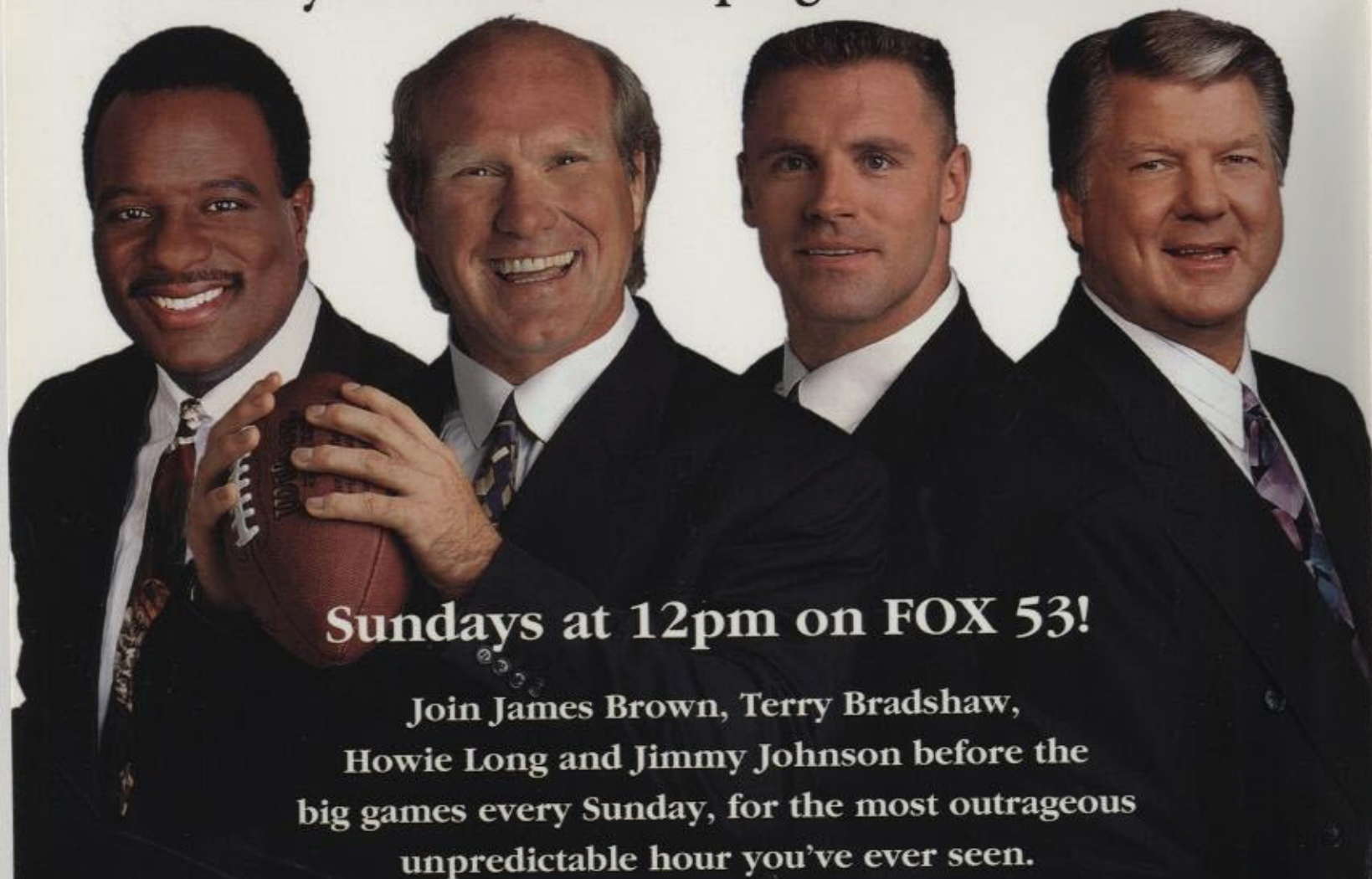

Please note our own locker room where I asked a few of my friends to display their actual (and signed) game uniforms.

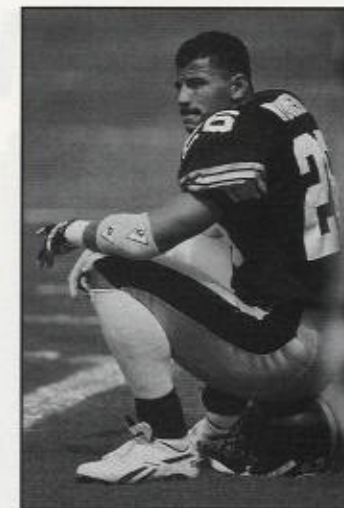
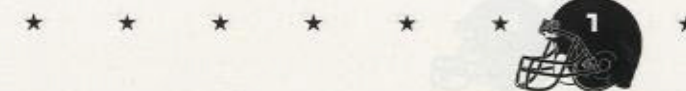

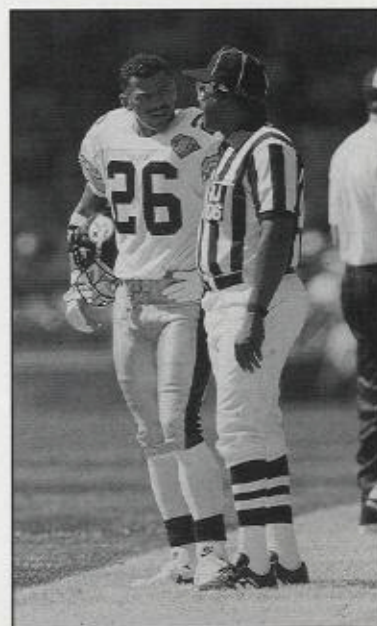
But those wildest dreams keep coming true for Rod. And the list of achievements seems to go on forever.




- High School: Football All-American, twice State Champion in track.

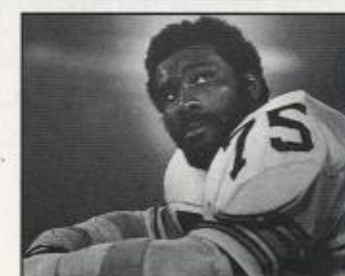
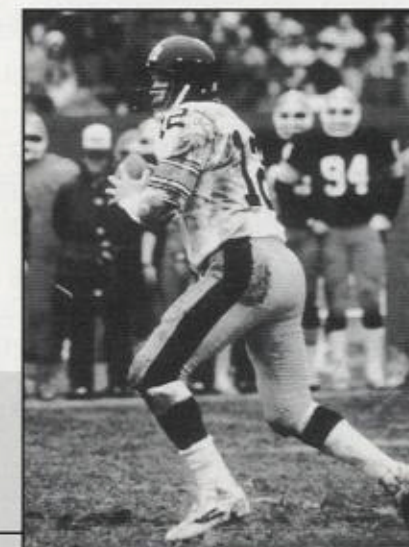


# Milestones of The Dynasty

It all started in the '30s when the Pirates, as they were known then, played at Forbes Field. Renamed the Steelers in 1941, they moved to the newly completed Three Rivers Stadium in 1970 and Terry Bradshaw led the team to a 5-9 record, setting the stage for the Steelers to become the "team of the decade."

1972 - The year of rookie Franco Harris and the "Immaculate Reception." Also the year the Steelers won their first division title with an 11-3 record.

1974 - The Steelers' first Super Bowl Championship. A year remembered for rookie Lynn Swan and the Steel Curtain defense. In Super Bowl IX, Harris rushed for a record 158 yards and the Steelers won 16-6.







## Milestones continued

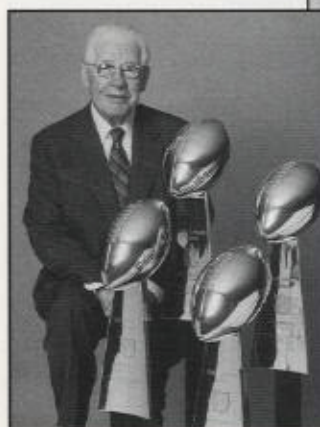
1975 - After an early loss to Buffalo, The Steelers won 11 straight games. Facing Dallas in the Super Bowl, Pittsburgh defeated the Cowboys 21-17.



1976 - The Steelers take their fourth straight division crown. The defense didn't allow a touchdown for 22 quarters and racked up three shutouts.

1977 - The Steelers won still another division title. Their fifth straight.

1978 - The Steelers showed the world what they were made of by becoming the first team in history to win three Super Bowls by beating Dallas 35-31.



1979 - Once again the Steelers astounded the entire country by winning their fourth Super Bowl, thrashing the Rams 31-19. Bradshaw picked up his second Super Bowl MVP title, and Harris tied Jim Brown's record with his seventh 1,000 yard season.

# Pirates

On April 15, 1876 The Pittsburgh Alleghenies brought professional baseball to the city for the first time by playing a game at Union Park. In little more than a century the Pirates have brought to Pittsburgh a history filled with World Championships, glory, legendary players and some of baseball's most dramatic leap-from-your-seat moments.



In 1900, Barney Dreyfuss acquired controlling interest of the Pirates and in doing so, completed the largest player transaction in Pirate history. Dreyfuss's 14-player deal, brought Hall of Famers Honus Wagner, Fred Clarke and Rube Waddell from Louisville to Pittsburgh. All would play significant roles in the Pirates winning pennants in 1901, 1902 and 1903, and the club's first World Championship in 1909.

The Pirates captured their second World Championship in 1925 when they came back from a three games to one deficit against the Washington Senators. Their miraculous comeback included a 15-hit pounding of Walter "Big Train" Johnson, another Hall of Famer, in game seven.



But it's the 1960 World Series that remains one of the most incredible post-season encounters ever on record. In the bottom of the ninth inning of the seventh game against the Yankees, with the score tied at 9, Bill Mazeroski belted what is perhaps the most dramatic home run in baseball history off Ralph Terry. Mazeroski's home run gave the Pirates their third World Championship.

During the 1960s Roberto Clemente established himself among the game's elite players. He collected more hits (1,877) than anyone during the decade and would go on to reach the 3,000 hit plateau in 1972. During his marvelous career he won four batting titles and was the League's Most Valuable Player in 1966.

The Pirates captured two more World Championships during the 1970s. Their 1971 victory over Baltimore was a showcase for Clemente who batted .414 and received the Series MVP award. However, Clemente's career came to a



tragic end, New Years Day, 1972 when he was killed in a plane crash. But the Pirates came back in 1979 to repeat their 1925 World Championship performance. The Pirates became only the fourth team in history to erase a three games to one deficit when they took the Orioles in seven games. Hall of Famer Willie Stargell lead the charge with a .400 batting average, three home runs and seven RBIs. For his efforts, he was named Series MVP.

The newest chapter of Pirate history began on October 2, 1985 when a group of public and private investors reached an agreement to purchase the Pirates from the Galbreath family and Warner Communications.

Pittsburgh Associates is made up of 10 investors who represent six corporations, three individuals and Carnegie Mellon University. The group includes the Aluminum Company of America, Mellon Bank, PNC Financial Corporation, PPG Industries, USX Corporation, Westinghouse Electric Company, businessmen Eugene and Raymond Litman, John McConell and Harvey M. Walken.

After several lean years in the mid-eighties, the Pirates returned to contention in 1988 when they finished in second place and broke the club's 28-year-old attendance mark.

Pittsburgh started the 1990s in fine fashion, winning the NL East title three straight years. Manager Jim Leyland took home NL Manager of the Year honors in both 1990 and 1992. Under the direction of Leyland only the Atlanta Braves have won more NL games than Pittsburgh during the '90s.





# Penguins

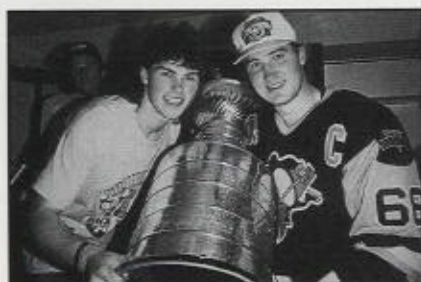
Pittsburgh Penguins superstar center Mario Lemieux will be back on the ice for the 1995-96 season.

Following consultations with a number of medical specialists, Lemieux decided not to play the 1994-95 season. He made the decision in order to rest and regain his strength after back problems and treatment for Hodgkin's disease had limited his playing time during the previous two seasons.

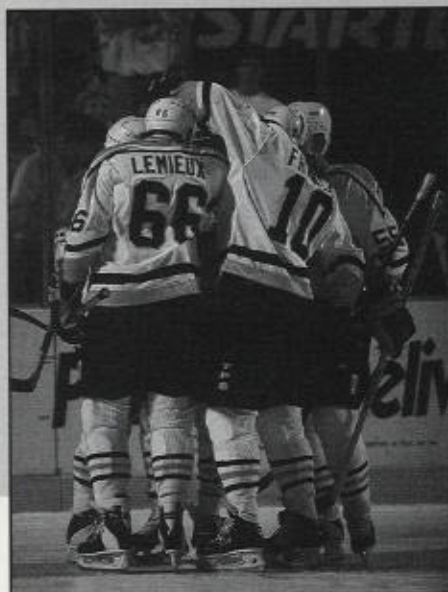
"This is a great day for the Pittsburgh Penguins organization," Chairman of the Board Howard Baldwin said. "However, I am happy not only for our organization and our fans, but also for the entire league. Fans everywhere can look forward to seeing this great player perform his magic. He is the ultimate talent in hockey today, and his charisma and greatness will be a big boost for the game at all levels in North America, especially in the new franchise cities that have never had the chance to watch him perform.

"Mario wisely took last year off. He dedicated himself to a physical reconditioning program, and his aim at all times was to play this season. He is healthy and ready to resume his brilliant career."

Lemieux, 29, who is entering his 11th NHL season, is anxious for the season to begin. "It's been a long year for me," he said. "I missed hockey in general and my teammates and fans in particular."



"I feel much better, and I definitely feel I did the right thing by taking a year off from playing. I am ready to come back and help the club compete for the Stanley Cup."



The Penguins major problem during the 1994-95 season was depth at center behind the talented Ron Francis. Lemieux solves a major portion of that depth problem, according to General Manager Craig Patrick. "With Mario and Ron Francis, we have the best 1-2 punch at center in the NHL,"

Patrick emphasized. "We still want to add to that depth, and I will continue working on that this summer."

"Having Mario back is a tremendous lift to the coaches and players. He is on another level as far as pure talent, creativity, on-ice intelligence and hockey instinct are concerned," Patrick added. "He brings the game to its highest possible peak. He has an intense fire to win, and he creates havoc for opponents due to his ability to adjust to any situation and make the right move under pressure."

"Hockey is fortunate today, because the league needs Mario Lemieux on the ice. He is simply the best player in the world."
